ENTRY FEE: \$8.00 per class. The RAS. charge a levy of \$1.15 per entry, per class which has been incorporated into the entry fees and will be passed on to them.

GROUND FEE: The fee of \$5.00 *per horse/pony* is payable with entry fees.

ADMINISTRATION FEE. The fee of \$5 *per rider/handler* is payable with entry fees

JUDGING TIMES: Prior to show day please check catalogue on main-events.com under documents for any changes to class times.

This show is run under the Royal Agricultural Society Equestrian, Competitors and Judges Rules.

BOXES & YARDS

Covered stables are available and will be allocated at the discretion of the convenor. Costs are \$10 for stallion boxes, \$7 for covered boxes and \$5 for open yards per night. You MUST state on the entry form which nights/days are required. Fees to be paid with entry. Tape yards are not to be erected on grounds.

YELLOW CARD - This Show supports the RAS 'Yellow Card' system. A Yellow card will be issued for offences of abuse of animals or inappropriate behavior as per the RAS Constitution and the RAS Rules & Regulations/Bylaws including the Equestrian Rulebook. Full wording of the 'Yellow Card' system is available to view on the RAS website - www.ras.org.nz.

PROTESTS - All protests must be left with the Secretary either before or after the Judges have proceeded to their duties. The party entering a protest must deposit \$100.00, which will be returned if the protest is sustained. If the protest be lodged before the Judges proceed to their duties, the onus of proof will rest with the exhibitor; if after that, the onus of proof will rest with the party protesting. The Committee will meet at the Secretary's Office at 4.30 p.m. approx. or at the conclusion of

the RTR on the Saturday to consider all protests: five members to form a quorum. All protests must be lodged within one hour after the exhibits are judged, or the awards distributed.

HEALTH & SAFETY PLAN

A copy of the Health & Safety plan is held in the Secretary's office.

PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR

All riders, including harness drivers, competing at RAS affiliated A&P Shows / Events must wear approved protective headgear. These must be tagged with a RED approval sticker prior to the day of competition. The current standards can be found at <http://www.ras.org.nz> – equestrian.

CLEAN SPORT - Competitors are advised that tests for forbidden substances may be carried out during the Show under RAS rules. A Forbidden Substance is: any substance capable of affecting the speed, stamina, courage or conduct of a horse, pony, donkey or mule by its action upon the central or peripheral nervous system or the cardio-vascular, respiratory, alimentary, digestive, musculoskeletal or urogenital systems.

RIGHTS OF COMMITTEE: The committee reserves the right to refuse or cancel any entry without giving any reason for doing so and reserves the right to make any alteration to the show timetable, or withdraw any event as may be deemed desirable. If there are insufficient entries in a class at close of entries, classes may be combined. Any unruly or dangerous animal or exhibit may be required to leave the showgrounds.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Online entries will not be downloaded or confirmed until payment has been received.
2. All Stallions and colts (with the exception of Miniature Horses and Foals) must be shown in a bit. All stallions and colts must be identified by two (2) official 'S' identification badges, one attached to each side of their bridle, at all Shows/Events at all times. The rider/handler must also wear two RAS official (2) armbands (one on each arm) when in the ring. 'S' badges to be purchased from RAS Head Office or ESNZ; Stallions are eligible for any ridden classes at the show. Please refer to rules CDE14 in the RAS Equestrian Rules.
4. In all Hunter, Horse and Pony Classes the bona-fide owner shall include a partnership that exists at time of entry and has been notified to the Association or registered with the Royal Agricultural Society. A lease shall comply with the same conditions. The Association may require evidence of the date of sale of an exhibit.

5. **SUBSTITUTIONS.** A veterinary certificate must be produced to the Horse Office staff prior to the event for any horse being substituted. The substitution **MUST** be owned or leased by the exhibitor in accordance with RAS Regulations.
6. **REFUNDS** – For any scratching on Veterinary or medical advice, a refund of 75% of the entry fee will be made. Advice of the scratching must be given prior to the judging of the class and the relevant Certificate to be given to the Secretary of the Association within 14 days.
7. All class changes to be made to the Secretary by 5.00 pm on Wednesday 2nd December 2020.
8. All Novice Horses and Ponies to be ridden in a snaffle bit (except Hunter Jumping Classes and Working Hunter).
9. All saddlery and accessories to comply with RAS Equestrian Rules GR 5
10. A Novice is a Horse/Pony is yet to win six (6) first placings in conformation classes at any A&P or RAS Affiliated Show at the time of the show. Wins accumulated in Hack Sections are transferable to the Saddle Hunter Section. Wins accumulated in Pony Groups A, B & C are transferred to Saddle Pony Hunter (Group D). District classes are restricted classes and wins do not count.
11. A Novice Hunter is a Hunter that has not won six (6) first placings in a Hunter Jumping event over fences at any A&P or RAS Affiliated Show at the time of the show.
12. Novices may enter the Open Classes.
13. Novice Champions are not eligible for Open or Supreme Championships unless they have won their respective Open Class. Champion does not count as a win.
14. If a novice entry has gained six wins by the day of the show the competitor must advise the Horse Office and may change the entry to an Open Class. If an Open Class is not available for entry, a refund will be given.
15. No Horse or Pony under 3 years old can be shown in saddle classes.
16. Riders of any age may ride ponies in Novice Classes. Riders age is taken as at 1 August 2020.
17. **Breastplate numbers and Sports Numbers only at this Show. Back numbers are required for the Hack and Pony Hunter Jumping events. The Back-Number listing will be available on the Main-Events.com website in the week before the show.**
18. By entering the show you forfeit all rights to hold the SSC Committee and CPSNZ inc. liable for any loss, damage or injury sustained to yourself, equines or personal property whilst on the show grounds – Entry is at your own risk.

MEASURING – There will be no measuring on show day. Measuring days as advertised on RAS website. Enquiries to Paula McIlraith 027 222 4473 or Tracy McIlraith Ph 027 200 0863. **Where height is a requirement of the section exhibitors must carry an official RAS Life or Annual Certificate and performance card. Failure to do so will result in elimination (CDE 1).**

First Ridden Ponies must be ridden in a snaffle bridle with a cavesson noseband, a snaffle bit and a single rein.

PLEASE NOTE: No cantering is allowed as a class, however the judge may ask for a canter in the individual workouts. A cane or whip not exceeding 68cm in length with a flap 2cm wide and 4cm long may be carried by riders in the First Ridden section. Pony Height certificates and performance cards must be carried. Failure to do so will result in elimination. Ponies height in this section must not be over 138cm and Ponies must be over 3 years of age.
