MASTERTON A&P SHOWING CHAMPIONSHIPS – SOLWAY SHOW GROUNDS 20TH AND 21ST FEBRUARY 2021 COVID -19 ALERT LEVEL 2 OPERATION PLAN – RIDERS AND SUPPORTERS MUST READ

Purpose

To outline to competitors, judges and officials how Masterton A&P Association will operate the Masterton A&P Showing Championship on 20th and 21st February 2021 under Covid-19 Alert Level 2 requirements.

Separate Gatherings

The event has been spilt into four separate gatherings, each under 100 people.

- Gathering A (maximum 100 people) located in and south of the Solway Oval,
- Gathering B (maximum 100 people) located in and north of the Solway Oval,
- Gathering C (maximum 100 people) located in and south of the Presidents Oval, and
- Gathering D (maximum 100 people) located in and west of the Sand Arena.

The Gatherings will be operated independent of each other, and areas defined through fencing, gates, tape and signage.

No Gathering can mix with another Gathering – this includes those camping within a Gathering. Those entered across multiple gatherings must stay in their allocated Gathering UNLESS it is their scheduled competition time. Then only the competitor and their nominated supporter can move to the competition area ONLY of the other Gathering. Please do not mingle within that Gathering.

Those CAMPING must park in your camping area, your horse must either be tacked up at your vehicle or transport gear across to your yard.

Each entered horse / pony is allocated one rider and one nominated support person only. There are no spectators or public allowed. Please arrive only as you require to prepare for your competition. Once you have completed your competition, please leave the Solway Show Grounds as soon as practical. Please do not stay longer to spectate.

Entry to and Departure from the Grounds

Gathering A will enter through the Gate at 48 Judd Road. Please park in the designated area south of the Solway Oval.

Gathering B will enter through the Fleet Street gate and turn left into the Cross Country paddock. Please park in this paddock only.

Gathering C will enter through the Gate at 18 Judd Road. Please park in the designated area south of the Presidents Arena.

Gathering D will enter through the Fleet Street gate and proceed down the driveway. Turn left at Main Show Office and park in the designated area by the Sand Arena.

Please refer to the Gathering Map which shows these designated areas. There is space between each designated area which no competitor or supporter can enter. These will be utilised for those required to move between Gatherings.

Please note that only Nominated Riders and Supporter's can enter the Grounds:

- Both must scan in using the Covid-19 QR code and/or sign in manually on the paper form
- For those who are required to move between gatherings for competition on Sunday, you will be required to scan into each Gathering.
- All competitors must wear their number when competing, riding or working their horse or pony.

Separate Gatherings

The following precautions are in place to meet Covid-19 requirements for separate gatherings. Each gathering has:

- A maximum of 100 people
- Separate parking points
- Check in process at each entry point only nominated riders and support people enter the grounds, QR code or manual sign in on arrival.
- Separate locations for parking, warm up and competition on the grounds.
- Separate yarding for camping and day competitors.
- Spaced yarding to allow for social distancing.
- Separate toilet blocks. No showers available to those Camping in each Gathering.
- Separate officials judges, writers, scorer and runner.
- Separate catering areas for officials.
- Regular cleaning of surfaces where practicable.
- Limit of one visitor to the office at any time.

Covid-19 Wellness Guidelines

- Physical distancing of 1 metre should be maintained, and 2 metres from people who you do not know this includes those who are camping
- Limit gatherings in trucks to no more than 10 people and record those who attended
- Wash your hands frequently with soap and water, or hand sanitiser
- Cover coughs and sneezes and dispose of tissues responsibly
- Use your own equipment for horse and rider
- Use your own ablution facilities in your trucks where possible
- Stay at home if you are sick or have been in contact with someone with Covid-19 in the last 14 days
- If you become sick with Covid-19 symptoms within 10 days of attending this event please seek medical advice and alert the Organising Committee
- Hand sanitiser will be available in the offices and toilet locations but we encourage you to bring your own for your vehicle
- Masks and gloves are a personal choice but we recommend you bring and wear your own masks and gloves where practicable
- Covid-19 information and posters will be displayed around the grounds.
