














































### **Terms and Conditions**

Late Fees 25% EXTRA. Refunds less 25% for scratchings made before Wednesday 24th of March. SCRATCHINGS MUST BE NOTIFIED by via EMAIL sjwaitemata@gmail.com (No phone messages, texts or Facebook Messages). No refunds for all other scratchings except on production of a medical or vet certificate which must be received within 48 hours of the finish of the show.

Admin and online entry fees are non-refundable.

Prize money will be paid out by direct credit. Please provide relevant bank account number at time of entry.

The organizing committee reserves the right to alter or cancel classes as they see fit and to limit classes if necessary.

Prize money paid as advertised then on a ratio of 1 to 7.

### ABSOLUTELY NO DOGS OR MOTORBIKES AT OUR EVENT

In the very unlikely case of complete show cancellation the organizing committee will retain the ground/admin and yarding fees to cover fixed costs.

All Competitors and spectators attend the event at their own risk.

ALL CLASSES will be run under ESNZ rules.

#### REGISTRATION & MEMBERSHIP

### Riders

Introductory members (Casual membership of \$15 per day) may be used to compete in Introductory classes (80 cm and under for ponies and 90cm and under for Horses - (named intro) if not registered as a ESNZ rider. All other riders must be full members with ESNZ.

### Horses

This is a ESNZ jumping show, all horses should be registered for Jumping with ESNZ. All horrses must pay \$5 Jumping levy per show (Compulsory). Horses Not registered with ESUNZ may jump Intro classes or ponies to 1metre and Horses to 1.10m in the open classes with a \$20 casual jumping levy paid - They cannot compete in series classes.

**Rookie Rider Class** - Open to riders Under 22 (as of 1st of August 2020) who have not placed in a young rider in the current season and are not competing in the Young rider class or events over 1.25m during the show

**Local Rider Trophies** (these are presented with 1st - 4th placegetters at our AGM and Prize Giving during the winter)

The following classes have local riders trophies.

Local riders - must live north of the Harbour Bridge and south of the Bryderwyn Hill. The area

includes West Auckland Maungataroto. If you live outside the area but keep your horses in the Waitemata area you can also qualify.

Anyone can enter these classes at the show however the local placegetters for AGM prizes will be taken with the following restrictions.

Arturo Stakes - Horses that have had less than 3 graded wins
Top Pony Stakes - Ponies that have had less than 3 graded wins
Open Horse Futurity - Open to all local horses
Newcomers Cup - Open to new combinations this season
Young Horse Wedgewood Blue Cup - Open to horses 6 and under
