#### HORSE ACCOMMODATION (MAP ON PAGE 13):

We have several different yarding options, each is limited and will be allocated on a first in first served basis when you place your entries. For those competing large teams or in series classes you can also pre-book yards prior to placing your entries by emailing horses@waiaps.org.nz

Covered yards with sawdust \$60.00 Covered yards with straw \$40.00

Wooden yards \$20.00

Wooden pony yards \$15.00 Open pipe yards \$20.00

Satellite pipe yards (close to powered sites etc) \$20.00

Swapping of yards without discussing and getting approval from the yarding manager is not permitted. Any horses in yards without their information tags or in the wrong yards will be impounded by the committee, these horses can be collected upon payment of a \$50.00 cash impound fee.

\$50.00 cleaning fee applies to any stables or yards not cleaned out prior to leaving the grounds.

CAMPING ON GROUNDS: No charge, free showers are available in the shower block at the Menz Shed

POWERED SITES: Are available \$15.00 for show

**ARRIVE EARLY/STAY LATE:** Competitors are welcome from Friday 27<sup>th</sup> March. Arrangements can be made to accommodate you and your horses before/after the show for \$5.00 per horse per day.

#### LEVIES:

A levy pack is required for each horse/pony. Third and subsequent horses are eligible for a \$10.00 discount. Example: If you are entering 5 horses your entries should show 5 levy packs and 3 discounts.

Please check page 11 for any special casual or introductory levies that may be required, an administration fee of \$5.00 applies for corrections.

#### Entries close on 15<sup>th</sup> March 2021

Late entries will be accepted but will incur a 50% penalty.

No email entries will be accepted however you can add/swap classes via email to horses@waiaps.org.nz Payment must accompany entries, any entries received but not paid by the closing date will be considered late. Entries will be accepted via the Main Events. The correct names and registration numbers of all horses, ponies and riders must be stated. Competitors must read the rules and check their entry form carefully.

Entry in this show confirms that you have read and accept the rules under which our event is run.

All riders, horses and ponies must compete with the appropriate ESNZ membership .

Times shown are approximate only and may va)ry dependent on entries.

Entry in the Show entitles the Society to publish competitors names and results and distribute with competitor Lists. The Society reserves the right to refuse or cancel any entry without giving a reason for doing so.

#### SWAP/SCRATCH/ADD CLASSES:

These can be done in the office or by email to horses@waiaps.org.nz

These only apply to horses and ponies already entered in the show, no new horses, ponies or riders can be added after late entries close on 26<sup>th</sup> March.

**Swap** – Class swaps after entries have closed will be charged at -75% of the original entry fee, plus the new entry fee. Late entry fees will not apply to swapped classes when the swap out of/into classes are nominated at the same time. **Scratch** – Per refund policy below

Add – Competitors will be able to place additional entries during the course of the Show. Additional entries will incur the 50% late entry fee

Any balance resulting will be followed up after the event (or can be paid in cash)

#### **REFUNDS:**

100% refund of entry including levies and yards if horse secretary is advised before 5pm on the 15<sup>th</sup> March 2021 75% refund of entry including levies and yards if horse secretary is advised before 5pm on the 26<sup>th</sup> March 2021 with a vet or doctors certificate for the horse or rider entered.

50% refund of entry including levies and yards if horse secretary is advised during the show or before 5pm on the 28<sup>th</sup> March 2021 with a vet or doctors certificate for the horse or rider entered.

#### DOGS:

Dogs are welcome at our show however they must be kept on leads and supervised at all times, any wandering or unsupervised dogs will be handed over to Carterton City Council Dog Control at the dog owners expense. No warnings will be issued.

#### STALLIONS:

Stallions must wear official stallion badges at all times and handlers must wear approved armbands. There are no stallion yards available.

#### PROTESTS:

Any protests must be lodged with the Horse Marshall within half an hour of results being posted, accompanied with a \$50 fee; to be forfeited if the complaint is not upheld.

All disputes will be settled by the judiciary committee consisting of the society's executive and marshal of the section concerned.

#### **CLEAN SPORT:**

The rules of Equestrian Sport New Zealand in regard to Clean Sport apply. Competitors are advised that tests for forbidden substances may be carried out during the Show/Event and that testing of all animals is at the person responsible's risk. **Forbidden Substance** – any substance capable of affecting the speed, stamina, courage or conduct of a horse or pony by its action upon the central or peripheral nervous system or the cardio-vascular, respiratory, alimentary, digestive, musculoskeletal or urogenital systems.

#### AGE OF RIDERS OR HORSES:

Riders age and eligibility is determined as per the 1<sup>st</sup> of August. I.e. Riders/handlers who are of age for any division/section on 1<sup>st</sup> August complete the show year/season in that division/section. Riders in horse rings (equines over 148cm) must be 12 years & over. The age of the horse/pony is calculated as from the 1st August per ESNZ series rules

#### SADDLERY & ACCESSORIES:

Whips in classes shall not exceed 76 centimetres in length.

Saddlecloths are optional however it is preferred that saddlecloths used and are at least are cut to the shape of the saddle.

Bearing reins, running reins or similar tack may not be used.

The misuse of a whip or spurs, or the committing of an act of cruelty by an exhibitor to his horse or pony within the limits of the showground, including rapping or misuse of a practice jump will be penalised.

Any such act must be reported by any horse/pony steward or judge to the Judicial or General committee.

#### HATS & SAFETY HELMETS:

Wearing a hard hat is compulsory for anyone competing on, working in, or schooling or riding a horse/pony in any area considered to be part of the showground.

All riders must wear protective headgear with the chinstrap properly adjusted and fastened when in the arena or ring, the practice area, collecting rings or anywhere else within the showground.

# Helmets must meet the required safety standards as of 1 August 2017. Red tag must be visible on helmet harness.

Helmet Tagging will be available at the show, please contact horse secretary to arrange prior to the show.

#### SAFETY:

In the interest of safety, the stirrup iron & the stirrup leather (this also applies to safety stirrups), must hang freely from the bar of the saddle and the outside of the flap. The rider must not directly or indirectly tie any part of their body to the saddlery, unless an exhibitor's disability card is held.

#### **MOTORBIKES/SCOOTERS:**

May be ridden within grounds by licensed holders and not after 10pm.

#### MEDIA:

By entering or attending the Clareville Classic Show competition you accept that you may appear within differing media streams that are on location covering the event.

Your behaviour at the event and within the competition arena is at your discretion and is your responsibility. Please note that there might be live streaming at the event therefore the camera is on throughout the day, there may also be several photographers on the grounds.

By entering the grounds you give permission for your photo to be taken and provided on their respective websites/facebook pages at the discretion of the photographer.

#### CATALOGUE:

A catalogue will be available online (Main Events) prior to the show for you to print.



All series classes will be run under ESNZ rules. The committee reserve the right to alter the programme/prize money as they see fit. These rules are in conjunction with those on pages 1-3 of this schedule.

#### ESNZ REGISTRATION AND LEVIES (All competitors please read)

\$5 ESNZ Jumping levy per equine, per show is included in the show jumping/show hunter levy pack. Unregistered riders may compete in classes 80cm and under for ponies, and 90cm and under for horses on a \$15 ESNZ Casual Membership (These classes are marked with a \*).

Registered riders may compete on unregistered horses in classes 100cm and under for ponies, and 110cm and under for horses with a \$20.00 ESNZ casual jumping levy (excluding series classes and championships) All other riders and horses MUST be full members with ESNZ. Results will be recorded with ESNZ for Introductory classes where that horse and rider have current ESNZ Memberships.

#### Levy Information 2020-2021

**\$5 ESNZ Jumping Levy (Compulsory)** – payable by all horses/ponies competing in Jumping and or Show Hunter, this is included in your levy pack.

#### \$20 Casual Jumping Levy

The rider must be a full member with ESNZ. Horse/Pony not registered for ESNZ J/SH can compete using this levy.

The levy is \$20 for the show.

Can jump up to 1.00m on a pony and up to 1.10m on a horse. Cannot compete in series classes and will not be eligible for HOY points in SH.

## Introductory Membership or \$15 Casual Membership Day Start

Riders may compete in Introductory class (80cm and under for ponies and 90cm and under for Horses) on an Introductory Membership or Casual Membership Day Start. All other riders must be full members with ESNZ – results will not be recorded with ESNZ for Introductory Classes.

Shows may choose to run registered classes at introductory heights where the rider must be a full ESNZ member and the horse may compete with a current Jumping/Show Hunter discipline start or on a Casual Jumping Levy – results for these classes will be recorded on ESNZ records where applicable
