ENTRY CONDITIONS

Dog Owners

All campers and competitors are advised that those bringing their Dogs with them must have them restrained at all times and all Dog droppings are to be picked up. Owners that have been identified as allowing their Dogs to roam free and unsupervised run the risk of elimination from a day's competition.

Note too that there is a Ranger who will be attending the area throughout the Carnival and those that are unrestrained will be caught and impounded.

- By entering this event, competitors are agreeing to abide by the EA Code of Conduct
- 10% discount on entries for all current financial MGSJC members as at close of entries.
- \$25 Administration Fee per customer
- \$25 Medical Levy per rider
- The MGSJC does not accept any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, grooms, officials, spectators, grounds or any other person or property whatsoever. Horses and riders compete at their own risk.
- Horses must be currently registered with EA, all Competition Licences must be presented to the ground jury on request. All riders to be members of EA.
- All events are judged under EA with FEI rules and regulations.
- The MGSJC have the right to alter or cancel a class or event, without notice.
- The MGSJC has the right to refuse entry to any person without being required to give any reason for such refusal.
- Any protest must be lodged in writing within 20 minutes and accompanied by \$100 – non-refundable unless the protest is upheld.
- Prizemoney will be posted within one week of the conclusion of the Show.
- · No HC entries accepted.
- Riders in ring 2 must be a member of EA or MGSJC.
- Horses may only be entered in two classes per day in ring 2.
- Horses may compete in either ring but as per EA rules are allowed only two starts per day.

Refund Policy:

- Administration Fee non refundable
- Entry fees, camping fees and medical levy for withdraw-als will be refunded until close of entries
- Entry fees from scratchings during the Show may be applied to alternate entries during this show only (will not be carried over)
- Scratchings accompanied by a Vet Certificate or Medical Certificate will be refunded

Horse Accommodation: The football grounds next to the Velodrome will be used to accommodate horses.

Build your own yards. **Maximum size 5m x 5m.** Must be of solid construction.

Stable accommodation at the Showgrounds, bookings to be made directly with the Show Society Ph 08 87251873.

Feed supplies delivered to the Velodrome – The Produce Store – Ph 08 8725 0377

Accommodation: Power for caravans, shower and toilet facilities available.

Camping fee - **\$60 per vehicle** for Carnival. Payment will be compulsory with entries. Entrants not camping will be refunded. Please see the office during the show to advise if you are not camping.

Thoroughbred Sport Horse Association (TSHA) Classes

Thank you supporting the TSHA. To be eligible for TSHA classes your thoroughbred must be registered with the Australian Thoroughbred Stud Book. No part bred thoroughbreds will be eligible.

To compete in the thoroughbred only classes you must purchase a competition licence with the TSHA through Global Entries Online. The licence costs \$ 55 and runs for a calendar year from the date you purchased it.

How do I obtain my licence?

- The licence can be obtained by logging into www. globalentriesonline.com.au
- · Go to the 'Manage Horses" page
- · Click on the "TSHA licence" button and fill in the details
- If you don't already have an account with Global Entries it is simple to create one and then follow the instructions above.

You must provide a microchip number. If this is not possible please provide your horse's race name and/or their breeding (dam and sire). If you are having trouble finding the information please send us an email and we can help you info@thoroughbredsporthorse.com.au. The licence fee is for competition purposes only and is not proof of ownership.

Any prize money will be paid to the winning rider. Connections of the horse must organise the prize money split, if any, between themselves.

Any horses and riders competing in the TSHA Thoroughbred classes 1.05m and over must also hold EA registration.
