1. Lead rein ponies are to be lead from the shoulder
2. Lead rein riders are NOT allowed to wear spurs or hold whips
3. First Year Ridden class is WALK & TROT only.
4. First Year Ridden riders are NOT to wear spurs
5. First Year ridden riders Can use a whip if under 76cm
6. First Year Ridden riders must be under the age of 12
7. Lead rein riders must be under the age of 8

4. Order will be selected prior to show date.
5. Workouts will be judged by 2 judges over score sheets.
6. Placings to 6<sup>th</sup> will be awarded
7. Combinations that were entered into pleasure at LHOY are able to enter the CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS free of charge. Proof of entry to hoy may be requested.

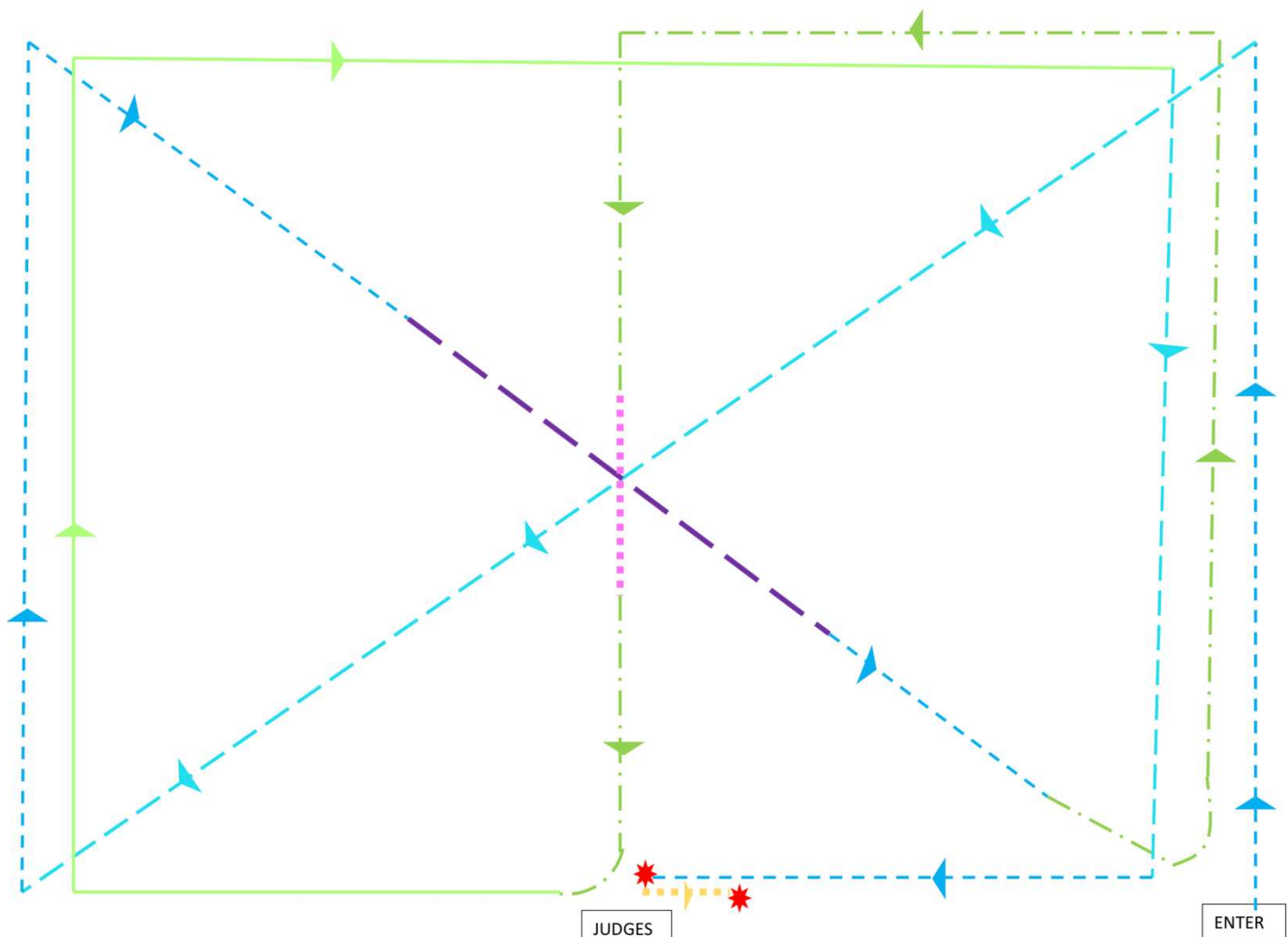
# LHOY PLEASURE PONY/HORSE WORKOUT 2021

1. Enter at trot, turn left along diagonal
2. Long rein trot along diagonal, collect reins and turn right. Continue working trot.
3. Turn right across diagonal, lengthened trot 7-9 strides in centre of diagonal.
4. Pick up working canter on left rein, turn left. Continue in working canter.
5. Turn left down centre line, change the rein through walk. Continue working canter.
6. Turn right and continue in long rein canter.
7. Canter along rein along long side.
8. Downwards transition to trot maintaining long rein. Turn right.
9. Continue long rein trot
10. Collect reins and turn right, continue working trot.
11. Halt. Pause.
12. Rein back 4-5 steps.
13. Halt.

# *PLEASURE HORSE/PONY SHOWING RULES*

1 August to 31 July

Pleasure Horse/Pony means those animals who do not fit the mould of a Show Horse/Pony. We welcome any breed (e.g. Appaloosas, Quarter Horses, Standardbreds, Clyde X) and colour. They should be an uncomplicated and genuine pleasure to ride. Whilst they do not possess the show quality conformation of a show horse, they should in their own way be a delight to ride, with impeccable manners.

A "pleasure mount" is NOT an inexperienced mount with show quality conformation who is destined for the open show ring.

1. From 1 August 2015, for a horse/pony to meet the annual title show qualification requirements they must be registered with NZEPS.
2. Horses/ponies must never have been placed first in an open show ring class including working hunter. However, members may apply for dispensation to NZEPS.
3. Ordinary snaffle bit As per Dressage nz definition only, no poll action. No bit guards, shadow rolls, ear plugs muffs or bonnets, martingales (breast plates are allowed) or tie downs
4. Bitless bridles are only permitted in Recreational pleasure classes.
5. Only cavesson nosebands are permitted no strapping below the bit .
6. Whips may be carried but must not exceed 76cms in length.
7. All riders must wear a 3 point harness helmet conforming to the current NZ Safety Standard or an equivalent standard and be red tagged.
8. Spurs are not to be worn.
9. Riders may be registered with other bodies.
10. Riders may have competed outside the Pleasure Horse/pony section.
11. Riders in Pony classes must be under 17yrs (proof of rider's age may be requested). Age is taken as at 1st August.
12. Children riding hacks must compete in the Horse Classes.
13. Adults may ride ponies in Horse Classes without prejudice.
14. Pleasure mounts may compete in recognized breed and colour classes ie welsh and pinto classes but should not compete in the ras inhand classes ie sporthorse, TB or in hand pony sections.
15. Stallions may compete but must have a "S" Band and be accompanied by a handler at all times.
