

Terms and Conditions

Entries OPEN now for May weekend; 17 May for Series #2; 14 June for Series #3 and 26 July for Final Series - eg day after previous show finished.

Entries CLOSE midnight on the Wednesday 10 days before each show.

This is the first season running a Winter Series, and as we have no precedent on entry numbers we reserve the right to limit class entries or horses at some point as appropriate.

Health and Safety Policy avaliable on request. By entering the show, you accept our Health and Safety conditions.

Conditions of Entry

1 Entries will only be accepted with full payment of entry and all other fees. Payment to be made by PoliPay unless otherwise pre-arranged with the show secretary.

2 All classes run under ESNZ rules current at the time of the show.

3 All riders compete at their own risk.

4 All riders, horses, and ponies must compete with the appropriate ESNZ membership.

5 Series classes as per Takapoto Winter Series conditions (see below).

6 The committee reserves the right to alter the programme and prize money.

7 All class changes must be made online through *Main-Events Messaging*; or at the office by 5:00 pm the day before. 80% of original EF refunded and then charged normal fee (not late) for class swapping into.

8 Refunds less 20% for scratchings made prior to 7PM on the Wednesday before the each show. No refunds for all other scratchings except on production of a medical or vet certificate.

9 No dogs allowed.

10 No horses to be tied to trucks. Limited day horse accommodation available depending on entries. 11 Formal or casual tidy dress code in all rings.

12 Riders' Bar open daily, any alcohol purchased elsewhere must not leave the truck park.

13 All yarded & stabled equines are to have their name, the name of the person responsible and the telephone number clearly visible on their head collar and/or rugs as per Jumping Rules 200.7.1.

14 In case of cancellation of the event the Admin fee and a percentage of entry fees will be retained to cover out of pocket expenses only.

Fees

Ground Fee \$30 per equine

Medic/Admin Fee \$10 per equine (non-refundable)

Stabling - compulsory for all equines as no horses allowed to be tied to trucks.

\$25 per day stable; or stables at \$100 per equine for Saturday & Sunday or \$125 for all 3 days (incl overnight) **Powered site** \$60 per site. Shower cards available from the cafe, bond payable

ESNZ Jumping Levy \$5 per equine.

ESNZ Casual Horse Registration \$20 for show.

ALL riders must be full members of the ESNZ as there are no intro classes at the show.

Takapoto Winter Series Leaderboard

Points will be awarded 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 to placegetters in all **Sunday** classes for each *Height level* and *Rider Series* as accumulated over the four Winter Series Shows. Prizes will be announced shortly.

The eligibility for the Rider based Series is loosely based on ESNZ Jumping Series:

• Takapoto Junior Rider Series - beginning of the season when they reach the age of 12 until the end of the season during which they reach the age of 18, the season being from 1 August until 15 August

• Takapoto Young Rider Series- beginning of the season when they reach the age of 14 until the end

of the season during which they reach the age of 21, the season being from 1 August until 15 August • Takapoto Amateur Rider Series - 22 years of age & older and must be a full/part owner or leasee of the horse. Rider must not have won prize money in any jumping class greater than 1.25m including Pro-Am Series or 3* Eventing during the current or preceding ESNZ season

• Takapoto Pro-Amateur Rider Series - 22 years of age & older and must be a full/part owner or leasee of the horse. Rider must not have won prize money in any jumping class greater than 1.35m during the current season.

Where a rider has two or more horses in the same *Rider Series* at a show, they must ride their nominated horse first. All Rider Series classes are horse classes.

Competitors may not compete in the Young Rider and Junior Series at the same event on the same horse; and competitors may not compete in the Amateur and the Pro-Amateur at the same event on the same horse.

Riders competing in conjoined classes will only be eligible for Series Points in the class entered - eg earn points for the Height OR the Rider but not both but will still be eligible for placings and prizemoney in the Height class.

The "season" for Takapoto Series classes has been extended to August 15th to align with the end of the 4th show in the Winter Series.

Full Series conditions will be posted at the show.
