Place getters with ponies that are <u>148cm and under in the 65cm class</u> will gain points towards the "Pony of the Series" over the 8 shows. The overall winner will be awarded a trophy sponsored by THE ROSSOUW FAMILY at the conclusion of the Winter Series. Please nominate pony's height when entering.

Place getters in the <u>95cm class</u> will gain points towards the "Horse of the Series" over the 8 shows. The overall winner will be awarded a trophy sponsored by THE RICHARDS FAMILY at the conclusion of the Winter Series.

Junior riders UNDER 13 YEARS, AT THE START OF THE SERIES (23/5/2021), will gain points towards the "Most Successful Combination" over the 8 shows. Trophies for 1<sup>ST</sup>, 2<sup>ND</sup> & 3<sup>RD</sup> sponsored by ARDOCH RACING will be presented at the conclusion of the Winter Series. The best classes will count. Please nominate pony's height when entering.

Riders on Thoroughbred horses will gain points towards the most successful combination over the 8 shows. At the venue running 2 rings, only the main ring will count for points. Only 2 classes per day will count. The overall winner will be awarded a trophy rug sponsored by SECOND CHANCE HORSES at the conclusion of the Winter Series.

FOR EACH OF THE ABOVE AWARDS YOU CAN COMPETE AT ALL 8 VENUES AND YOUR 6 BEST SCORES WILL COUNT, HORSES/PONIES ARE ELIGBLE FOR 3 CONSECUTIVE CLASSES.

Class 1: Open 55cm, Optimum Time (1<sup>st</sup> Prize donated by the Carraill Family)

Class 2: 65cm Pony of the Series, 238.2.2 (1st Prize donated by Von Duve Plumbing)

Class 3: Open 65cm, 238.2.2

Class 4: Open 75cm, 238.2.2

**Class 5:** Open 85cm, 238.2.2

Class 6: 95cm Horse of The Series (1<sup>st</sup> Prize donated by Whicker Family)

Class 7: Open 105cm, 238.2.2

\*Classes 2 & 3 to be run concurrently.

Horses competing in Ring 1 are ineligible to compete in Ring 2.

## Ring 2: Encouragement Ring 9.30am Start.

Class 8: Open Poles on Ground – Optimum Time, Riders may be assisted.

Class 9: Open 30cm – Optimum Time, Riders may be assisted.

Class 10: Open 40cm – Optimum Time

Placegetters in Ring 2 do not accumulate points towards the Green Triangle Series Show Jumping series. Horses competing in Ring 2 are ineligible to compete in Ring 1.
