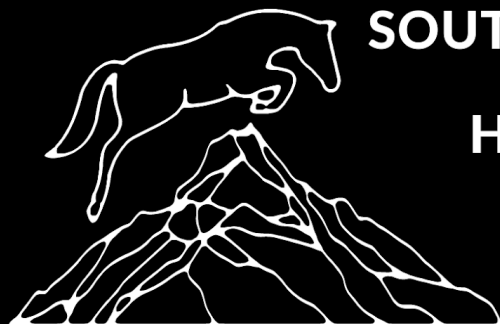

SHOW HUNTER CONDITIONS

- ▶ All horses/ponies may start in any class under the Casual Start System **EXCEPT SERIES CLASSES** where horses/ponies must hold an annual jumping start registration.
- ▶ Horses/Ponies with an annual registration will gain HOYQ points in classes designated HOYQ – note that qualifying for HOY is now a condition not a rule.
- ▶ **Pony High Points** - ponies may only enter the High Points class appropriate to their height.
- ▶ Classes may run back to back at judge's discretion.
- ▶ Scores under 66% will not be placed.
- ▶ Max of 2 horses/ponies in the arena at any one time during practice rounds.

GENERAL SHOW CONDITIONS

- ▶ It is the rider/owner's responsibility to ensure **all** horse/rider registrations are current as at the date of the show.
- ▶ Riders competing in introductory classes only either need a casual membership (see below) or be an introductory member, no horse registration required.
- ▶ Open classes, all riders must be fully registered, horses must have either a full registration or a casual registration (see conditions below).
- ▶ Equines may only start in one championship or grand/mini prix class.
- ▶ Competitors ride at their own risk.
- ▶ Committee reserves the right to alter, amend or delete any class/prize money as it deems fit. In the event the show is cancelled, the administration fee is non-refundable.
- ▶ Minimum Standard of dress required for Introductory classes. Formal standard of dress required for all other classes.
- ▶ Run under ESNZ/ESNZ Jumping/ESNZ SH rules and regulations. Please see the ESNZ website for current Rules and Series/High Points conditions. www.nzequestrian.org.nz
- ▶ **Stallions**: it is the competitors responsibility at attach a stallion sign to their stable door.
- ▶ **Dogs** must be on a lead at **all** times and any dog poo must be picked up immediately.
- ▶ All horses **must** wear an ID on their horse with the person responsible's name & phone number at all times when they are not being ridden. This is to ensure the person responsible can be contacted promptly if your horse gets loose.
- ▶ Pony riders **must** carry a current RAS height certificate (i.e for annual certificates these must be issued on or after 1 August 2021). Please ensure this is also sent to ESNZ before you compete in any show hunter classes otherwise ESNZ will disallow any points you earn.
- ▶ SCNO riders must submit the online helpers form at sporty.co.nz/scnosj to nominate a helper and what jobs they can do to assist with at the show (entry will not be accepted without a completed helpers form). **Working Bee times will be posted on our facebook page.**

- ▶ Yards/stables will **only** be allocated once payment has been received. If you have a preference of what yards you want it is recommended you enter early or requests may not be able to be granted.
- ▶ **Online entries - www.main-events.com - EVENT ID is SCNO.** Bank Account 03-0887-0277958-000.
- ▶ Entries will only be processed ONCE payment has been received. **Late entry fees (50%) will be added** if payment is not received by the close of entries. **Entries will be declined** if payment is not received at least 48 hours prior to our show.
- ▶ **Refunds/Prize Money will be paid out within 21 workings days following the show. Bank Account numbers to be provided with entry.**

SCRATCHINGS AND CLASS CHANGES

- ▶ Scratchings prior to close of entries or riders when have been issued with an ESNZ Blue card – Full refund (excl nonrefundable admin fee)
- ▶ Scratchings after close of entries - 75% refunds given with proof of inability to compete.
- ▶ There will be no refunds given on late entries.
- ▶ Scratching from a class and entering another class – 75% refund on scratched class, normal entry fee on new class entered.
- ▶ Scratching from class and no other class entered - No refund
- ▶ Changes must be made 30mins before the start of the class.
- ▶ All changes must be made through the office or any partial refunds will not apply

COVID-19 Policy



Every person on the grounds participating in this event has specific obligations under this policy.

A reminder that failure to follow the conditions outlined in this policy may result in immediate disqualification from the show and removal from the grounds.

At all settings

- **You must stay at home if you are unwell.**
- **Everyone over the age of 12 years and 3 months must have a My Vaccine Pass.**
- **Everyone aged 12 and over must check-in** – QR codes are placed at all access gates and the office. If you cannot check-in using the app – please do so at the show office.
- **Face coverings are encouraged.**
- **Practice good hygiene** – Wash your hands frequently, cough/sneeze into your elbow, and use the hand sanitiser and/or hand washing facilities provided.

Red setting

- **No spectators or members of the public** – only competitors, support persons (1 per competitor), and officials/volunteers are permitted to enter the grounds. All support persons must be named prior to the show. We will keep a record of all attendees and their contact details, and will provide this to the Ministry of Health if requested.
- **Everyone aged 12 and over must have a face covering** – Face coverings are mandatory inside all public buildings. When unmounted they are mandatory outdoors in all common areas, these include; shared laneways, warmup rings, and the entire area and road encircling the main oval. Face coverings must also be worn in other areas when distancing requirements can not be maintained.
- **Keep your distance** – Maintain a 2 metre distance from people outside your bubble at all times.
- **Base yourself at your car/truck/float** – use it for storing your belongings, resting, and picnicking. Please make use of your own toilet/shower facilities if you have them.

Competitors/support persons

- Are split into separate designated areas of up to 100 persons, with separate parking, yarding, and toilets for each area.
- You must not enter a designated area to which you have not been assigned at any time. Anyone found to be in breach of this condition will be disqualified from the show and asked to leave the grounds.

- No refunds will be provided if you do not abide by our rules and guidelines.

Officials/volunteers

- You are all considered part of one workplace bubble. The rotating of officials will be avoided when possible. Car parking is in the shingled area behind the Office/A&P Shears Pavillion.
- You must wear a face covering at all times if you are required to enter a designated area to which you are not assigned, or when you interact face to face with competitors/support persons (presentations, course walks, etc.)

Indoor Areas

- Only 2 competitors/support persons are permitted in the office at any one time. Electronic methods for class changes will be available and encouraged.
- The toilets in the common area at the A&P Shears Pavillion are solely for the use of officials/volunteers. Anyone that has paid to use the shower facilities may do so.
- Hand sanitiser and/or hand washing facilities will be available at all indoor areas.
- Officials/volunteers lunch will be served seated, not buffet style.

First Aid and Emergencies

- Minimum distances do not apply, but close contact should be kept to less than 15 minutes.
- Appropriate PPE must be worn if the patient is exhibiting any COVID-19 symptoms.
- A supply of surgical masks and gloves will be held by the organising committee.

Designated Areas

Blue

- All blue yards and all rodeo yards
- Parking between yards and ring road, and between creek and warmup rings.
- Toilets: Permanent toilets on the northeast side of the ring.

Green

- Competitors not staying on the grounds..
- Parking off Queen Street/Mt John Road.
- Toilets: Portaloos in the parking area.

Red

- All red stables, yellow yards 1-24 & 105-114, and black yards 21-60.
- Parking between yards and ring road, and in paddock adjacent to yards.
- Toilets: Portaloos in the parking areas.

White

- All cream stables & yards, and black yards 1-20.
- Parking between yards and ring road/trot up ring, and in paddock adjacent to yards.
- Toilets: Permanent toilets on the southwest side of the ring.

Yellow

- Yellow Yards 25-104 & 115-120.
- Parking in paddock.
- Toilets: Portaloos in the parking area.

Health & Safety Policy



The SCNO Area ESNZ Jumping Committee has no employees and is a volunteer association. It is not a person conducting a business or an undertaking (PCBU) and has no duty, responsibility or liability under the Health and Safety at Work Act (HSWA), however we still have responsibilities for public safety under other legislation for which WorkSafe is not the regulator.

We are committed to providing and maintaining a safe and healthy event for all, and to providing the information, training and supervision needed to achieve this.

We will take all practicable steps by;

- Providing a safe event, safe equipment and proper materials
- Identifying and monitoring hazards and using the hazard management hierarchy of eliminate, isolate or minimise.
- Insist upon establishment of safe methods and best practices
- Comply with all applicable H&S legislation, regulations and codes of practice

We will take responsibility for health and safety procedures, however, **all people on this site** need to be aware of their responsibilities and comply with the event's health and safety policy.
