General Conditions

- 1. Covid Policy
 - a. Under Red & Orange Traffic Light System: Vaccine Passport system will be in playb. Under Green Traffic Light System: Open to both Vax and Unvaxxed with bubbles
- 2. All entries must be made on official ESNZ entry forms. Entries close on Fri 1st December with Rebecca Drummond email <u>southlandshowjumping@gmail.com</u>
- 3. Bank direct to SBS 03-1355-0619034-000 be sure to use your name as reference.
- 4. All entry fees and prize money are inclusive of GST.
- 5. All competitors (inc unregistered), send full entry fees, **Including a \$5 NZ Showjumping Levy per horse/pony.** Plus a ground/administration fee of \$15 per horse/pony. The ground/administration fee is non-refundable, non-deductible, regardless of scratching.
- 6. Stabling available for Covered Yards (New Stables) \$40, Old Stables \$30 & Yards \$15 for the duration of the show. **Entry fees must be paid before stables/yards will be allocated.**
- 7. Yards/stables will be allocated once payment has been received. If you have a preference of what yards you want it is recommended you enter early or requests may not be able to be granted.
- 8. There are no restrictions on how many classes you may enter, but please consider the welfare of your horse or pony. Organizers have the right to restrict the numbers of classes you are entered in if the number entries are excessive.
- 9. It is the rider/owner's responsibility to ensure all horse/rider registrations are current as at the date of the show. You will NOT be able to start the competition without this being cleared.
- 10. Riders competing in introductory classes only either need a casual membership (see below) or be an introductory member, no horse registration required
- 11. Open classes, all riders must be fully registered, horses must have either a full registration or a casual registration (see conditions below).
- 12. The committee reserves the right to alter or amend the program as it sees fit.
- 13. All competitions will be run under ESNZ rules.
- 14. Junior rider under 18 as at 1st August 2021.
- 15. Formal dress code for ring one. Art 265.1.5
- 16. All Southland riders must complete the attached form and supply a helper. <u>https://forms.gle/QUBn9wmdcxkmAoCn8</u> Failure to do so will incur a \$100 fee payable before you are able to start in your first class. Working Bee times will be posted on our facebook page.
- 17. Stallions: it is the competitors responsibility at attach a stallion sign to their stable door.
- 18. Dogs must be on a leash at all times!
- 19. No two wheeler motorbikes allowed.
- 20. No electric fencing allowed.
- 21. All horses must wear an ID on their horse with the person responsible's name & phone number at all times when they are not being ridden. This is to ensure the person responsible can be contacted promptly if your horse gets loose.
- 22. Entries will only be processed ONCE payment has been received. Late entry fees (50%) will be added if payment is not received by the close of entries. Entries will be declined if payment is not received at least 48 hours prior to our show.
- 23. ESNZ BLUE CARD ruling for concussion will apply.
- 24. Health and Safety protocols with be available for viewing in the office and must be complied with as a condition of show entry.
- 25. ESNZ GRs Article 151: Regarding tagging protective headwear will apply
- 26. By entering or attending the show you accept that you may appear within differing media streams that are on location covering the event. Your behaviour at the event and within the competition arena is at your discretion and is your responsibility.
- 27. Horses/Ponies can only start in ONE championship class or Mini Prix or Grand Prix.
- 28. Pony riders must carry a current RAS height certificate (i.e for annual certificates these must be issued on or after 1 August 2021).
- 29. Refunds/Prize Money will be paid out within 21 workings days following the show. Bank Account numbers to be provided with entry.

Show Hunter Conditions

- 1. Any class with less than 5 entries may be combined.
- 2. Show Hunter classes run under ESNZ Show Hunter Rules & Equitation Series Conditions 2020
- 3. All riders competing in Show Hunter HOYQ and Series Classes must have a current ESNZ Rider full Membership
- 4. Riders competing in WELCOME Classes can be registered or compete on a Casual Membership
- 5. Equines competing using the ESNZ Casual Equine Start will not gain any HOY Points and cannot compete in **ANY** Show Hunter Series Classes.
- 6. For show hunter high points classes ponies may only enter the category appropriate to their height.
- 7. Show Hunter prize money only paid out to qualifying scores over 65.

Show Hunter Conditions

- 8. Horses/Ponies with an annual start registration will gain HOYQ points in classes designated HOYQ
- 9. Classes 106 & 206, Open to any height pony but rider must be 12 years or under as at 31 July 2022. Pony riders can ride in either equitation classes, NOT BOTH.

SCRATCHING AND CLASS CHANGES

 Scratchings prior to close of entries or when riders have been issued with an ESNZ Blue Card - Full refund (excluding ad min fee)

- Scratchings after close of entries 75% refund (excl admin fee) with proof of inability to compete.
- No refunds on late entries (entries after official close of entries)
- Scratching from a class and entering another class 75% refund on scratched class, normal entry fee on new class.
- Scratching from class and no other class entered no refund
- Changes must be made 30mins before the start of the class
- All changes must be made through the office or any partial refunds will not apply.

COVID Protection Framework Policy

Red Setting

Every person on the grounds participating in this event has specific obligations under this policy.

A reminder that failure to follow the conditions outlined in this policy may result in immediate disqualification from the show and removal from the grounds.

General

- You must stay at home if you are unwell.
- Everyone over the age of 12 years and 3 months must be able to provide their MY VACCINE PASS and ID to verify this if required.
- No spectators or members of the public only competitors, support persons, (1 per competitor), and officials/volunteers, listed sponsors or trades are permitted to enter the grounds. All support persons **MUST** be named at entry on Main Events prior to the show and MY VACCINE PASSES PROVIDED. We will keep a record of all attendees and their contact details, and will provide this to the Ministry of Health if requested.
- Everyone aged 12 and over must check-in QR codes are placed at all access gates and the office. If you cannot check-in using the app please do so at the show office.
- **Physical distancing of at least 1 metre** must be maintained at all times, and distancing of 2 metres minimum is highly encouraged.
- Everyone aged 12 and over must have a face covering Face coverings are mandatory inside all public buildings. When unmounted they are highly recommended outdoors in all common areas, these include; shared laneways, arenas, warmup rings, and the entire grass area and road around the arena. Face coverings

are not required when in the saddle, participating in the round or around your vehicle base

- **Base yourself at your car/truck/float** use it for storing your belongings, resting, and picnicking. You should complete your round etc and then return to the area from which you have come from. Please make use of your own toilet/shower facilities if you have them.
- **Practice good hygiene** Wash your hands frequently, cough/sneeze into your elbow, and use the hand sanitiser and/or hand washing facilities provided. Wash or sanitise your hands after using shared equipment. Hand sanitiser stations will be available at entrances to all competition arenas and at all practice fence areas, toilets and the secretary's office.
- Additional restrictions may apply as government guidelines are updated.

Competitors/support persons

- Are split into separate designated areas of up to 100 persons, with separate parking, yarding and toilets for each area.
- You must not enter a designated area to which you have not been assigned at any time. Anyone found to be in breach of this condition will be disqualified from the show and asked to leave the grounds.
- Upon your arrival to the grounds **please report immediately to the office to check in and receive your wristbands.** If the office is closed at your time of arrival please report as soon as it is open in the morning. Spot checks will occur during the duration of the event. Any competitor or support person in breach of this will be sent home immediately and no refunds provided.
- No refunds will be provided if you do not abide by our rules and guidelines.

Officials/volunteers

- You are all considered part of one workplace bubble. The rotating of officials will be avoided when possible.
- You must wear a face covering at all times if you are, or when you interact face to face with competitors/support persons (presentations, course walks, etc.)

Indoor Areas

- Only 2 competitors/support persons are permitted in the office at any one time. Electronic methods for class changes will be available and encouraged. Masks must be worn
- As we share the grounds with other users. The showers located in the Grandstand Pavilion are **NOT** available for **ANYONE**. There will be no shower facilities for the

duration of our show. Hand sanitiser and/or hand washing facilities will be available at all toilets. Use your own ablutions in truck/float if you have them.

• Only use toilets allocated to your designated area

Site Hygiene

• **General rubbish bins will NOT be provided for this event.** Each person must manage and remove their own rubbish from the grounds. Rubbish bins will be provided in the toilets for the sole use of disposing of hand towels only.

First Aid and Emergencies

- Minimum distances do not apply, but close contact should be kept to less than 15 minutes.
- Appropriate PPE must be worn if the patient is exhibiting any COVID-19 symptoms.
- A supply of surgical masks and gloves will be held by the organising committee.

Site Safety Information and Rules

- There may be strict parking requirements. Weather dependent. All parking signs and advice must be adhered to or you will be asked to move. Trucks and 2WD vehicles have precedence to park on gravel if required.
- The Gore A&P Showgrounds venue is a multi hazard area. Please be aware of the following potential hazards/risks while at Gore A&P Showgrounds.
- Keep your head up while moving around the venue. Uneven surfaces and and grounds with potential to create trips, slips, falls or issues for machinery being used.
- Weather on occasion rain can cause pooling and minor flooding around the property. It is recommended that flooded areas are avoided and should not be driven through if it will cause vehicles or machinery to become stuck or unstable
