<u>Northland Jumping Covid-19 Framework Red – GP Show Response Plan</u> & how the event will run under COVID LEVEL – Protection Framework Red

This event is being run under the Covid 19- Vaccination Certificate Passports for events. – No vaccination passport No entry.

SIGN IN – Mandatory Contact Tracing is still compulsory – The covid app can be located at the gate on entry, The Toilet Block, The office- Please ensure you scan in

Contact tracing is mandatory. A QR code will be available for scanning in (there will be a have manual contact tracing register on hand for those unable to sign in the QR code.) This can be found by the office on a table outside. Every support person in your vehicle must also register or be added to details on the person scanning. In addition,. (Please limited your support people to 1 where possible, (unless arranged prior) spectators will be allowed to enter the grounds for this event as long as they present their Covid Vaccination Certificate for Verification by Heather (Location Ring 2) They may also have to watch from a designated Spectator Area.

OFFICE

Located in the main building on the middle level and will be open from 7.30am - 8.15am only both days for any changes required – unfortunately the office won't be open all the time as Heather is now also course building - please follow the details posted on the Office window if you come when its closed. Masks are compulsory when coming to the office. This is the only area that both bubbles can come to at same time, please keep a 2m distance while waiting. You will be in charge of ensuring your own scratchings and change of class paperwork gets to the rings required. Heather will be in the office at the end of the day to do any changes for the following day.

RINGS- Each Ring Area can still only have 100 people in Framework Red

Jumping will be running with 3 rings. Ring 1 &2 will be combined on the top level Ring 3 will be below the main building. Showhunter will be located on the bottom level. SJ Rings are both near full capacity of riders and extras. So please respect the rules re crossing areas- Spectators from the top level you can watch ring 3 from – the hill beside ring 1 or from the deck by the office.

WATCHING OTHER RINGS

We will have tapes placed across area top of hill between top and second level where those from Ring 1 &2 can stand at watch downhill. Please do not cross any of these barrier tapes. Those who are also by the office area will be able to watch Ring 3 from the deck, again please do not cross the taped area.

PARKING/MOVING BETWEEN BUBBLES

- If you are Showjumping mainly in ring 1&2 parking will be around Ring 1.
- If you are riding mostly Ring 2, but have some classes in 1 & 3, please park next to ring 2 inside the gate or on A&P Ground (Wash-down bay side) – And ride to other areas
- If you are riding most of your classes in Ring 3 or Showhunter plus other equines in Ring 2 or 1 as well you are to park on level 2 and ride up to Ring 1 and 2 please.
- Access down to the SH ring will be down the bush track in corner on middle level. Head past water jump to Lower flat – you will also return this way Only 1 support person may go with horses heading to other areas must also walk that way ... do not cross over any tapes into separate Areas, x 1 support person moving bubbles must wear a mask- once you have jumped in new area you are to return to your original bubble.

(YOU ARE NOT ALOWED TO RIDE UP AND DOWN THE DRIVEWAY – THIS IS FOR VEHICLES ONLY) Stay on the Grass or to designated path way

If you are doing majority of SH classes + some SJ, you are to please park at Showhunter and ride up To SJ via the water jump then into ring 3 area or up to top Ring 1. You will also return this way Only 1 support person may go with horses heading to other areas must also walk in ally way ... do not cross over tapes into separate Area x 1 support person moving bubbles must wear a mask- once you have jumped in new area you are to return to your original area.

CLASS/DRAW & DETAILS

All rings are draw order, we are aware some riders are in all both rings, please ensure you inform gate keeper you are coming to your class before going to another ring, those who are riding in all rings keep an eye on timings and draw you may be riding in ring 3 or 2 before 1 or vice versa. Please be prompt to your ring, check in with the gate keeper, warm up and be ready- we ask **No more than 6 jumping at a** time in the warm up area, use the rest of the top level to do your flat work.

We understand that riders may be delayed at other rings, it's your responsibility to let the ring know that you are still coming so the class can be held open for you. A class will be held for no more than 15 minutes.

Rings on Saturday and Sunday start at 9am

SPECTATORS- In Framework Red we are allowed some spectators come onto the park, please don't invite your whole family – These spectators must have their vaccination Certificates to be allowed access – you must come with them to see Heather to have their passport scanned. Depending on numbers these spectators may have to watch from a designated area, so tell them to bring a chair. Jumping areas- Only those names as extras with online entries will be allowed in. You need to

make arrangements with the Event Secretary's Heather Deane for Jumping and Jo Thomas for Showhunter to check with numbers to enter area. Please only try to have that one person per rider please.

FACE COVERINGS

You must legally wear a face covering if you are aged 12 & over in certain circumstances such as inside a retail business and you are strongly encouraged to wear a face covering when you cannot maintain your physical distance from others. In an equestrian context, face coverings must be worn in all indoor areas and where physical distancing of 2 metres is not possible outdoors. Face Covering Must be worn when you are at the **secretary's office or dedicated space**.

Face coverings are not required when in the saddle or participating in the round.

All we ask at the practice day is if your 2m distancing can be achieved you must wear a must, please no standing in big groups, once you have finished return to your trucks.

If you are a support person with a rider crossing into another area, you must wear a mask.

PERSONAL AND SITE HYGIENE

General rubbish bins are not provided for this event. Each person must manage and remove their own rubbish from the grounds.

All people on site for this event are expected to practise good hygiene: IF YOU ARE UNWELL STAY HOME.

- 1. Do not touch eyes, nose, or mouth if your hands are not clean.
- 2. Wash and dry hands with soap after using toilet and before handling food. Sanitising should be completed as a secondary line of defence to hand washing.
- 3. Cough or sneeze into your elbow to prevent potential spread of COVID-19. It will keep the virus off your hands, so you will not spread it to other people and make them sick too.
- 4. Regularly clean surfaces that get touched frequently.
- 5. Maintain physical distancing. Keep a safe distance from people you do not know while out and about. This will help reduce the spread of COVID-19 if community transmission returns.

FOOD AREAS / TOILET FACILITIES

Each Bubble is required to have both -

TOP LEVEL – Ring 1 &2 Coffee and Cream and Café de Curb will service this area. Please follow covid guidelines from the food outlets (you may be required to scan in again)

MAIN TOILET BLOCK ON TOP FOR THESE RINGS

MIDDLE LEVEL – Ring 3 – Tiffanies Café in the main building will be your port of call for food and coffee for Saturday– Sunday we will position Café de curb in carpark to service both areas.

TOILETS you may use side toilet by café if you are a paying customer or else the internal toilets by the office, there will also be a porta- Loo on the middle level.

LOWER LEVEL – Showhunter – they will join the tiffanies café group, would be preferred if you can come up my vehicle, if you must walk you will need to wear a mask and walk up the main drive without stopping at Showjumping. (You become our numbers- and this area doesn't have much to play with)

TOILETS The Toilets for both Showhunter and Yard users are the green shed by the yards.

Food areas and toilets are considered a common area. Masks are mandatory to place an order or pick up food. It is expected you will place your order and maintain physical distancing whilst waiting for your order and leave at the earliest opportunity. Please use contactless payment if possible.

YARDS/CAMPING/SHOWERS

If you have booked a yard for the weekend these will not be allocated, so please just pick your yards, you can change the second night, please ensure that these are cleaned at the end and chain returned correctly.

Camping- you can either park up by the yards and camp and drive to your areas each day or walk your horses to the yards at the end of the competition day.

Showers are located at the bottom shed only.

OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION - PLEASE READ

Assisting with course changes

 We ask for all riders and extras help with the process (SJ people will be also allocated sections as ring crew) you need to assist with picking up rails and any other directive by the CD – Please either

Sanitise your hands at the gate or with your own sanitiser, masks are not compulsory but if you wish to wear you may do so.

Please just use common sense and follow social distancing guidelines and any direction given to you by the organising committee.

- Riders that are riding multiple horses please make sure you're a prompt in changing mounts Make sure you let the gate keep know you still mounts to come or are in another ring.
- NO standing in large groups and just sitting around on your horses if you have finished your round please return to your truck and wait for your next class or help with the ring.

 Please Take all Horse Manure and hay waste with you. Bring extra feed bags to put this is. Leave the park clean and tidy
