CHAMPION TO BE JUDGED FROM WINNERS OF CLASSES 14-17 (SECOND PLACE GETTERS TO STANDBY)

- 1. Competitors and public enter and complete at their Own Risk. Please note that the Tuki Tuki river runs beside the ground. Access to the river is not permitted during this event and please ensure any young child are supervised at all times.
- 2. There is no water on the grounds be sure to bring with you water for yourself and your horse/pony.
- 3. Please ensure all manure, hay and rubbish is taken away with you.
- 4. Absolutely no dogs allowed on the grounds under penalty of disqualification.

- 5. Approved (red tagged) safety helmets must be worn at all times when mounted.
- 6. Committee reserves the right to adjust the Age groups depending on entries.
- 7. Numbers will be capped and no late entries, or entries on the day will be accepted so that the show can proceed in Alert Level 2.
- 8. Entries close on 3rd November or earlier if classes are full. Entries must be paid in full of they will not be accepted and no refunds unless vet or doctors certificate produced.
- 9. Notification that the classes are full and/or cancellations or postponements due to bad weather will be posted on the Havelock North Pony Club and NZ Equestrian Pleasure Society facebook pages.
- 10. Covid scanning or signing in is mandatory when entering the grounds.
- 11. If required due to number of entries, Ring one (Hacks) will be held in separate bubble to Ring Two and Three (Ponies). If this is required then competitors and support persons are to remain in their respective bubble at all times.
- 12. Please only bring one support person per rider.
- 13. Stallions may complete but will be asked to leave if causing any disruption or endangering any other person or equine.
- 14. This is a Land Rover Horse of the Year Qualifier and NZEPS rules will apply as below.

PLEASURE HORSE/PONY SHOWING RULES

Pleasure Horse/Pony means those animals who do not fit the mould of a Show Horse/Pony. We welcome any breed (e.g. Appaloosas, Quarter Horses, Standardbreds, Clyde X) and colour. They should be an uncomplicated and genuine pleasure to ride. Whilst they do not possess the show quality conformation of a show horse, they should in their own way be a delight to ride, with impeccable manners. A "pleasure mount" is NOT an inexperienced mount with show quality conformation who is destined for the open show ring.

- 1. From 1 August 2015, for a horse/pony to meet the annual title show qualification requirements they must be registered with NZEPS.
- 2. Horses/ponies must never have been placed first in an open show ring class including working hunter. However, members may apply for dispensation to NZEPS.
- 3. Ordinary snaffle bit as per Dressage NZ definition only, no poll action. No bit guards, shadow rolls, ear plugs muffs or bonnets, martingales (breast plates are allowed) or tie downs
- 4. Bitless bridles are only permitted in Recreational pleasure classes.
- 5. Only cavesson nosebands are permitted no strapping below the bit.
- 6. Whips may be carried but must not exceed 76cms in length.
- 7. All riders must wear a 3 point harness helmet conforming to the current NZ Safety Standard or an equivalent standard and be red tagged.
- 8. Spurs are not to be worn.
- 9. Riders may be registered with other bodies.
- 10. Riders may have competed outside the Pleasure Horse/pony section.
- 11. Riders in Pony classes must be under 17yrs (proof of rider's age may be requested). Age is taken as at 1st August.
- 12. Children riding hacks must compete in the Horse Classes.
- 13. Adults may ride ponies in Horse Classes without prejudice.
- 14. Pleasure mounts may compete in recognised breed and colour classes ie welsh and pinto classes but should not compete in the RAS In-hand classes ie. sport-horse, TB or in hand pony sections.
