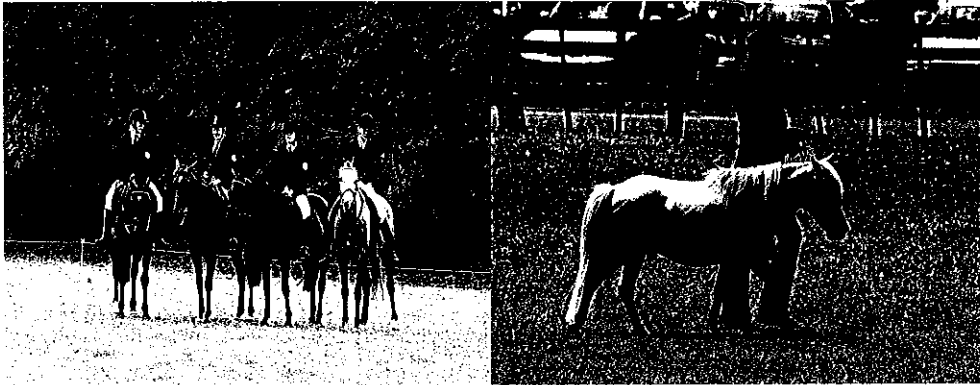

RULES AND CONDITIONS

ENTRIES ON LINE:- www.main-events.com ALL COMPETITORS MUST BE FULLY VACINATED AND HAVE A PASSPORT: To be sent in along with Height Certificate at time of entry. Will be checked on entry to grounds. If show is cancelled due to Covid 19 a partial refund will apply. Entries close on Friday 14th January 2022. NO LATE ENTRIES.

ROTORUA A & P RUNS UNDER ALL RAS RULINGS INCLUDING REMITS PASSED LAST AGM ALL HELMETS MUST HAVE CURRENT RED TAG - RAS RULES AS AT 01/08/17.

1. No entries will be acknowledged unless accompanied by fees.
2. Run under the By Laws and Regulations of the RAS and or Local Conditions as designated.
3. Each exhibitor must supervise and control their animals at all times and shall be liable for any hazard created, or accident, illness or damage caused by the action of themselves or their animals at the show grounds. Exhibitors must comply with the appropriate animal legislation and the HEALTH AND SAFETY EMPLOYMENT ACT 2015 and any amendments.
4. The Rotorua A&P Assn is an affiliated A&P Show to the RAS of NZ Inc. And as such, the use of tranquillizers, stimulants, or any drugs capable of affecting the performance of horses and ponies is forbidden.
5. Competitors are advised that tests for forbidden substances may be carried out during the Show and that testing of all animals is at the owner's risk. Testing for forbidden substances will be carried out under the Royal Agricultural Society Clean Sport Judicial Committee (CSJC) procedures and rules (refer rule CS RAS Equestrian Judges and Competitors Rule Book.)
6. This Show supports the RAS 'Yellow Card' system, which operates in the Equestrian Section of all RAS affiliated Shows and will be offered for any inappropriate behaviour towards Show officials, Judges, fellow competitors or any other third party connected with the Show bringing the equestrian discipline into disrepute, or cases which are of a less serious nature to the above in accordance with the Conduct of Members, Owners, Lessees, Competitors and/or Exhibitors as provided in the RAS Equestrian Competitors and Judges Rulebook. Implementation of the "Yellow Card" will be in accordance of the RAS Rules that accompanied this Card, and full wording of the "Yellow Card" system is available to view on the RAS website.
7. No person who is in arrears with regard to entry fees, subscriptions or any other Show charge is eligible to compete at any A&P Show. Proof of payment will be required before any restriction will be lifted.
8. The Rotorua A&P Assn Show Committee reserves the right to refuse or cancel any entry without adducing any reason for so doing.
9. No substitutions of any entries are permitted. Horses and Ponies that qualify for Champion or Supreme Classes must be ridden by the same Rider in which it qualified..
10. Cups/Trophies will be presented to the winners and then retained by the Assn. To be displayed in Barclay House. The A&P Assn will engrave cups/trophies with the winner's name. A photographer will be available if required.
11. Except in rider classes, every animal must be named.
12. A Novice pony or rider is one that has yet to win six classes in any division within the competitions provided at any A & P Show. Novice animals are eligible for open classes.
13. Novice ponies may be ridden by riders of any age.
14. In all jumping events, a skullcap must be worn. NB: All riders 16 years and under must wear headgear which includes a retaining harness secured to the shell at more than two points. Such headgear must be worn with the chinstrap properly adjusted and fastened when in the arena or ring, the practice area, collecting rings or anywhere else within the showground's.

15. No dressage type whips are allowed in ridden classes. Refer RAS rule.
16. The measuring rules of the RAS of NZ will apply at this show. All entries (Hacks, Ponies and Miniature Horses) entered in any height classes must have a current height certificate. If Height Certificate not able to be produced on request - No start permitted.
17. Starting times are approximate only, but will be adhered to as closely as possible. Although it is provided that horses may compete in more than one class, any or all of such classes may be judged simultaneously at the convenience of the Judges or Stewards, in all such cases exhibitors having an exhibit entered in more than one class must elect in which class they compete. The Steward will call their name twice only. Entry fees will not be refunded if an event is missed through not hearing the call.
18. It is the intention of the Rotorua A&P Assn to give winners names for publication in the local newspaper.
19. A ground levy of \$10.00 per horse/pony (Competing in Rings 1 - 7) will be charged to each competitor. This is indicated on the entry form.
20. Scratchings: Refund of entry fees will be considered if scratchings are made in writing officially with the Secretary by Tuesday prior to the show. Refunds will be less 25% of the original entry fee. Veterinarian/Doctors certificate is required for scratchings during the show. Refunds are at the discretion of the Show Committee.
21. All competitors must park their floats and trucks in the area designated for this purpose. **NO EXCEPTIONS.** All Hack and Pony competitors are to enter via Stenbridge Road entrance. (Refer to map) Some hack competitors may be directed to the Western Road parking area. Those camping will be given preference.
22. Application for pens must be made and paid for with entries. Pens are \$10.00 per horse for show. All horses staying on the grounds over night **MUST** be yarded. **NO GRAZING IN RINGS OR ELSEWHERE PERMITTED.**
23. All exhibitors in Rings 2-4 and Show Hunter Rings will be issued with a back number. Breastplate number holders will be allowed.
24. All dogs must be kept on a leash while on the showground's under penalty of elimination.
25. Financial Members of the Rotorua A&P Assn for 2021/2022 year may deduct 10% from their total entry fees as member's discount.
26. All prize money will be paid in cash on the day of the show. Any queries must be lodged within six weeks of the shows completion. Prizes not claimed within two months of the show will be deemed invalid. The Committee reserves the right to substitute product / vouchers for prize money.
27. RAS Height Certificate and Performance Cards: It is the responsibility of the owner/rider to present these to the Horse/Pony Ring Office for updating. No Card - No Ring Entry - No Placing - No Prize Money. New Age of Riders are as at 01.08.2021.
28. Sponsors product / vouchers may be presented in lieu of prize money.
29. Protests:
All protests must be in writing and be entered within 30 minutes of the class being completed. The party entering the protest must deposit \$50.00 cash. This deposit will be refunded if the protest is sustained. The protest committee will consist of the Ring Steward of the ring concerned and the Head Steward (Hack or Pony) of the ring concerned.

RULES:

1. EACH COMPETITOR MUST ANNUALLY REGISTER THEIR THOROUGHBRED WITH RAS HEAD OFFICE (NO FEE REQUIRED) PRIOR TO ENTERING THEIR FIRST LIVAMOL CLASS. 2. IF THE RIDER/COMPETITOR CHANGES THEN THE THOROUGHBRED MUST BE RE-REGISTERED WITH RAS WITH THE NEW RIDER/COMPETITOR. A NEW NUMBER WILL BE ISSUED. 3. TO REGISTER THE THOROUGHBRED THE HORSE MUST HAVE AN ALLOCATED THOROUGHBRED LIFE NUMBER. 4. EACH RAS (ACCEPTED) REGISTERED THOROUGHBRED WILL RECEIVE AN RAS REGISTRATION NUMBER – THIS NUMBER IS TO BE ENTERED ON THE A&P SHOW'S ENTRY FORM (OR ONLINE). 5. IF NO REGISTRATION NUMBER IS ENTERED, ENTRY WILL BE DEEMED INVALID and NO POINTS WILL BE ALLOCATED. PLEASE NOTE POINTS ARE ALLOCATED PER INDIVIDUAL RIDER/COMPETITOR/HORSE. 6. CLASS TO BE JUDGED: 80% CONFORMATION 20% PACES & MANNERS. 7. PLACINGS 1st to 4th WILL ACCUMULATE POINTS THAT WILL RESULT IN AN OVERALL SERIES WINNER – SERIES WILL CONCLUDE AT 2022 HOY. ANY LIVAMOL SERIES HELD AT SHOWS AFTER 2022 HOY WILL BE POINTS THAT CAN BE CARRIED THROUGH TO NEXT SEASON – 2022.2023. 8. A FEATURE CLASS WITH SPECIAL PRIZE MONEY WILL BE HELD AT 2022 HORSE OF THE YEAR - POINTS FROM THIS CLASS WILL BE INCLUDED IN THE SERIES. 9. Pleasure Showing Rules:

Pleasure Horse/Pony means those animals who do not fit the mould of a show horse/pony. We welcome any breed (e.g. appaloosas, quarter horses, standardbreds, clyde x) and colour. They should be an uncomplicated and genuine pleasure to ride and whilst they do not possess the same quality conformation of a show horse, they should be in their own way be a delight to ride, with impeccable manners. A pleasure mount is NOT an inexperienced mount with show quality conformation who is destined for the open ring.

1. From 1/8/2015 for a horse or pony to meet the annual title show qualification requirements they must be registered with NZEPS.
2. Horses/ponies must never have placed first in an open show ring class including working hunter. However, members may apply for dispensation to NZEPS. **Please note:** open show ring includes wins in novice classes in a ring defined open – saddle hunter, park hack etc. This also includes NZ Show Council and Showing Championships.
3. Riders may be registered with other bodies.
4. Riders may have competed outside the pleasure section.
5. Riders in pony classes must be under 17yrs (proof of age may be requested). Age is taken as 1st August.
6. Riders under 17 on a hack must compete in the hack ring.
7. Adults may ride a pony in the hack ring without prejudice.
8. Pleasure mounts may compete in recognised breed and colour classes i.e. welsh and pinto classes but should not compete in Royal Agricultural Society (RAS) led classes i.e. sport horse, thoroughbred or led pony sections.
9. Stallions may compete in this section however it is up to the discretion of each showcommittee as to whether they choose to allow stallions on site.
10. **Bits** – ordinary snaffle as per dressage NZ definition only. No poll action. No bit guards, shadow rolls, ear plugs/muffs or bonnets, martingales (brestplates and neck straps are allowed) or tiedowns.
11. **Bitless bridles** – are only permitted in recreational pleasure classes not HOYQ.
12. **Nosebands** – only cavesson nosebands are permitted, no strapping below the bit.
13. **Whips** – may be carried **but must not exceed 76cm in length.**
14. **Helmets** – must have a wear a 3-point harness and conform to the current NZ or equivalent safety standard (red tagable).
15. **Spurs** – must not be worn.
16. **Use of illegal gear at events prior to competing in a pleasure class** – no pleasure horse mount shall present to the ring including warmup area directly before pleasure showing classes with illegal gear, this includes dressage whips, spurs or other gadgets.
