

COMPETITOR INFORMATION – IMPORTANT PLEASE READ

Welcome to our 2022 Ubersnug NZSHC Nationals. Not long to go now. Below is some important information that we bring to your attention.

ENTRY TO GROUNDS

Grounds will open at 1pm on Wednesday 9th February 2022.

TRUCKS

If you have toilet and shower facilities in your truck/float we ask that you use these at all times please

SUPPORT PEOPLE

Please ensure support people are registered with NZSHC prior to entry, one per horse allowed

GEAR

In first ridden a simple snaffle bit with a cavesson noseband is permitted. Whip length is not to exceed 40cm, no spurs permitted. A narrow strap maybe attached to the front of the saddle

In lead Rein a simple snaffle bit with a cavesson noseband is permitted. Whip length for handler is not to exceed 40cm, no spurs permitted. A narrow strap maybe attached to the front of the saddle

Over-Height classes same rule as per above

GN Qualifier classes whip length is not to exceed 72cm.

Martingales, any kinds of gadgets (tongue ties, bearing, side, running, balance reins etc), any kind of boots or bandages, any form of blinkers are forbidden in ALL classes.

Bits other than types of :- Simple Snaffle, Wilkie or Baucher, Pelham, Weymouth Bit & Bradoon are not permitted

ADDITIONAL ENTRIES

If the horse/pony and/or rider is already entered in the show you may enter additional classes.

JUDGING

The committee is aware there are some conflicts of interest, and we may need to change judges allocated for some classes. Newcomer and Childs classes will have 1 allocated judge per class, GN classes will have 3 judges and Galas, TB, Fashion and Fancy dress will have all judges.

COVID RESTRICTIONS AND BUBBLES

Please find below the NZ SHC Covid-19 Management plan for running the show under the NZ Government "Red" level setting.

The Committee have decided to run under four pod structures, being:

- **Green Pod – Camping with Stables**
- **Blue Pod – Camping with Yards**
- **Pink Pod – Day Competitors**
- **Executive – including Committee, Volunteers, Judges.**

The pods will be positioned as follows:

Green Pod – Camping with Stables - These competitors will enter via gate 13 of Elwood Road. This will lead them direct to park around the stable block with their horses and camp here. There is also request for powered sites that will be positioned by the horse office. The bathroom (toilet and shower) facilities for these competitors are the Plunket rooms.

Only when riding will these riders and their 1x support person be able to cross the bridge to enter the competition area in and around the presidents arena.

Blue Pod – Camping with Yards These competitors will enter via gate 7 of Elwood Road and requested to park from the left of gate 7 up until their yards, adjacent to Elwood rd where there is powered sites. This area will be roped off. The toilet facilities for these competitors will be the block in this carpark,

under the trees by the driveway. If they want to camp in their floats/trucks – this is allowed but horses are to be kept in yards only over night and the toilet/shower facilities designated to their pod in the car park.

Pink Pod – Day Competitors - These competitors arriving and leaving each day will enter via gate 1 of Kenilworth rd. They will be asked to follow the tar seal track, that leads down to the day competitors park as identified in the pink bubble attached to this document. Bathroom facilities for this pod is the block in the members car park.

Executive – Judges/Committee members & volunteers will enter gate 7, and be asked to park by in the small cornered off area to the right of gate 7 (next to the presidents arena).

All vehicles in all the pods will be asked to space out when parked in their designated car park and enforced to only enter competition area when it is their time to compete. At all times they are requested to socially distance by remaining in & around their truck/float.

Competitors will be assigned and informed of their pod and a gate steward will be positioned at each gate ticking off names and giving out wrist bands for their pod colour on their arrival, it will be also at this time that vaccine passes will be checked and all persons asked to sign in.

During the two days of competition, there will be 1x food vendor truck, the mobile food box, and 1x coffee cart onsite. Both vendors have been asked to display their vaccine pass on arrival. They have ensured they will run their business by following the Government Covid-19 requirements. Competitors will be asked to ensure they are socially distancing when ordering and waiting for food and wearing masks. Only once their order is ready that they can then take their food/coffee straight back to their truck to eat, so mask is worn at all times when away from their vehicle. It is expected that no one will be standing at these sites for longer than 15minutes.

The Committee are strictly following NZ Government requirements and enforcing:

- EVERYONE (12 years and above) attending the show MUST be double vaccinated
- Masks must be worn by everyone over the age of 8 (riders and leader exempt) at all times.
- Competitors can only have 1 additional support person per rider/horse combination (please ask if you need clarification around this as names have to be nominated on entry and will be checked at the gate)
- We will have different bubbles (as outlined above) so people will be required to comply with ruling around these
- Toilet and bathroom facilities are segregated into pods as outlined above. Horse wash facilities are also segregated, with green pod using the wash bays in their car park and pink pod using wash bay across the oval.
- Everyone will be required to sign in and provide vaccine pass on arrival at NZSHC show
- All support people must meet all Covid requirements (i.e., CVP pass) and have their names recorded with NZSHC Secretary against the rider they are supporting.
- All people and vehicles will be required to check in to the grounds on arrival. The manner of doing this will depend on the day you arrive.

- No riders or supporters will be permitted into the competition area without appropriate wristbands (distributed when you check in).
- Vehicles turning up to the event with unauthorised people in (i.e., not approved supporters) will be turned away. This will be strictly enforced.
