REGULATIONS AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- The Event shall be run in accordance with the Show Horse Council of Australasia Inc. Competition Rules, General Rules and Special Rules pertaining to this show. A copy of the Competition Rules can be obtained from your Association Secretary or from the Show Secretary, at <u>secretarynzshc@gmail.com</u>. Copies will also be available from the Secretary's Office at the Show or they can be downloaded from the Council's website <u>www.showhorsecouncilaust.com.au</u>
- 2. The NZSHC Inc. Committee reserves the right itself to interpret all questions and conditions and shall make any relevant decisions in regard to, or arising from any incident at or pertaining to this Show, without claim for damages or recourse of any kind. Any questions not covered in the Conditions of Entry will be decided by the NZSHC Inc. Committee. Its decision will be final.
- 3. Entry and Competition in the Event are voluntary. By Entry it is the Absolute Liability of all participants to agree to be bound by the decisions of the NZSHC Inc. Committee and/or Show Horse Council of Australasia Inc. and compete in accordance with all Rules applicable to the Competition.
- 4. Entry to this Event shall constitute an agreement and affirmation by the Exhibitor(s)/Owner(s), Responsible Officer (which includes Lessee(s)/Manager/Rider/Handler) to compete subject to and in accordance with the Show Horse Council of Australasia Inc. Competition Rules and Conditions applicable to this Event.
- 5. Exhibitors must choose between entry in Show Hack, Galloway or Pony Classes and Show Hunter Hack, Galloway or Pony Classes. No exhibit can be shown in both the Show and Show Hunter Classes. Once entries have been received by NZSHC they cannot be changed under any circumstances, including postponement of the show.
- Confirmation of NZSHC membership for the 2021/22 membership year shall accompany all entries. Exhibitors/Competitors the NZSHC Risk Management Policy applies to all persons competing &/or attending the Event. A Copy of the Policy will be available on the day at the Show Office.
- Should any information or fees be omitted from the Entry, the Entry will be deemed incomplete and as such will NOT be accepted. <u>Entries will not be processed until monies have cleared</u> in the bank.
- 8. Numbers corresponding to the catalogue shall be worn. Breast Plate numbers on horses in Led and Saddle classes. Horse entries shall be catalogued as per Exhibitor(s) on Entry Form.
- 9. The NZ Show Horse Council Inc. shall not be responsible for the loss of or for any damage or injury occasioned to any Exhibit or the property of any Exhibitor(s) from any cause whatsoever.
- 10. The Exhibitors and Competitors enter and compete entirely at their own risk.
- 11. Except where any ineligibility is officially determined, the Judge's decision is FINAL. A Judge's decision representing his/her individual preference cannot be protested against.
- 12. All protests shall be in writing to the Ground Jury accompanied by a fee of \$100.00 and are to be received no later than one hour after the Event, after which time no protest shall be entered.
- 13. No outside assistance is to be displayed during Competition. Penalty of Disqualification may apply to breach of this Regulation.
- 14. Drug testing may be carried out during the Show in accordance with Show Horse Council of Australasia Inc. requirements. Competition Rules on DRUGS and DRUG TESTING (Rules 7.1 -

7.12 in accordance with the relevant Laboratory Sample Collection Protocol. Compliance with this Rule is mandatory for all Exhibits and Persons Responsible. Drug Penalties as adopted in the Show Horse Council of Australasia Inc. Competition Rules (7.8a & 7.8b) will apply. Registration papers must be produced if a horse is called up for drug testing. Drug testing guidelines can be obtained from the Show Office on the days of the event or can be downloaded from the Council's website www.showhorsecouncilaust.com.au

- 15. It is the intention of these Regulations that all horses shall perform at the time of competition on their merits, without the aid of any Drug(s) or Prohibited Substance(s) which will affect the conduct, performance or appearance of the horse.
- 16. It is the Absolute Liability of the Owner(s)/Lessee(s) Competitor/Exhibitor(s)/Responsible Officer to ensure that any horse exhibited by them in this competition is free from any Prohibited/Banned Drug or Substance at the time of Competition. Failure to adhere to this Rule may render the Competitor/Exhibit/Owner(s) Lessee(s), /Exhibitor(s) /Responsible Officer liable to disqualification and/or disciplinary action as determined by the Show Horse Council of Australasia Inc.
- 17. Results of Drug Testing may be published.
- 18. A TREATMENT FORM (available from the Show Secretary or can be downloaded from the Council's webpage www.showhorsecouncilaust.com.au) shall be completed and lodged by the Responsible Officer for ANY HORSE WHICH HAS BEEN ADMINISTERED ANY DRUG OR PROHIBITED SUBSTANCE within 30 DAYS prior to this Competition. The Treatment Form shall be accompanied by a VETERINARY CERTIFICATE containing full details of any ailment and/or injury and treatment and be forwarded to the Show Secretary within 24 hours of the initial treatment. If initial treatment occurs within 24 hours of commencement of the Show the Treatment Form must be lodged with the Show Secretary as soon as possible, but no later than 7.00am on the day of Competition. Where the horse requires continued treatment (after the form is lodged), a written report detailing the treatment shall be submitted prior to the day of competition.
- 19. The decision as to whether the horse will be permitted to start shall be made by the Ground Jury. Veterinary advice may be sought if considered necessary. The Exhibitor/Competitor shall be advised of the decision prior to the commencement time. No (a) claim shall be made against or (b) appeal made to the Ground Jury or Council if, by such decision of the Ground Jury, the Entry is not permitted to start.
- 20. The Committee reserves the right to refuse or withdraw any Entry/Entries without having to assign a reason.
- 21. All information supplied by the Exhibitor(s), Competitor (s) and/or Owner(s) and/or Lessee(s) and/or Responsible Officer, (i.e. the person in charge of the horse) shall be true and correct and represent that the horse/rider is eligible to compete. If this information is found to be false, the exhibit shall be ineligible to compete. The Show Horse Council of Australasia Inc. may discipline the Exhibitor(s), Competitor (s), Lessee and/or Owner(s) and/or Responsible Officer of the Entry.
- 22. Horse entries shall only be accepted where the name(s) and signature(s) of the current registered Owner(s) &/or Lessee(s), Responsible Officers and Exhibitors/Competitors appear on the Entry Form.
- 23. Where an Owner/Lessee of the horse shall be in charge of the horse during the Competition, then THAT Owner/Lessee is required to sign the Entry Form as the Responsible Officer.
- 24. If a person other than an Owner/Lessee shall be in charge of the horse during the Competition, then THAT person is required to sign the Entry Form as the Responsible Officer.
- 25. Where a horse is registered and/or entered in the name of a minor (under 18 years), the Entry Form shall be signed by the parent/legal guardian. <u>That Parent/Guardian MUST be a member</u> <u>of an Association affiliated NZSHC .</u>

- 26. In the event of Disciplinary Action, the person(s) considered responsible shall be the Owner(s)/Lessee(s) and/or the Responsible Officer and/or the person in charge of the horse at the time of the Offence.
- 27. The Organising Committee and/or the Ground Jury, reserve the right to alter the number of Finalists, Program, Judges, Schedule or Timetable.
- 28. All exhibits must be measured prior to competing at the show.
- 29. Conflict of Classes: It is the intention of Management to avoid delays in the Competition. To avoid disruption, Competitors must advise the Show Marshal and Ringmaster of the clash prior to commencement. Should an Exhibitor or Rider competing in a Class require competing in another ring, "holding" of the horse in the ring is NOT permitted. If such a conflict occurs, under the direction of the Ringmaster, the horse shall be excused from the Judging Area to the Holding Area and shall return to the ring upon the return of the rider.
- 30. Every effort will be made to accommodate a conflict. However, in any case, a ring will not be held up. If a conflict occurs, a period not exceeding FIVE (5) minutes will be allowed to a Competitor/Exhibit in the Holding Area before incurring elimination from the Class.
- 31. All Riders are required to wear an approved helmet and riding boots at all times. Any breach of this Rule, may incur disqualification from the Competition.
- 32. Major Prize Money will be forwarded on confirmation of Swabbing Results.

33. CLOSING DATE OF ENTRIES on <u>www.main-events.com</u> 6th February 2022.

34. All horses competing under saddle, to be 3 years old or over as at the 1st August 2021. NO stallions allowed in ridden classes.

35. In the Open Show and Open Show Hunter Classes (12), Open Leading Rein Classes (2), Rider Classes (7) and Childs day classes (12) both the Champion and Runner Up are eligible to compete at the 2023 Grand Nationals, Sydney, Australia.

36. NZ show Horse Council uses the current Show Horse Council Australasia judging system, as follows. Each judge has a separate score sheet. They place their horses one to ten, one (1) being first choice. All other horses are given an eleven (11). The judges must sign their score sheets. On completion of judging the steward collects each Judges sheets for the scorers to tally & enter on a Final Score Sheet, the two (best) lowest scores are counted the (worst) highest score is discarded. Therefore, the lowest collective score is the winner, going up the line to tenth place which receives the highest collective score". In case of equality of scores, the preference of the nominated presiding Judge prevails. The judges will each be allocated a letter (A, B, C or D) and will be drawn out of a hat prior to the show.

37. Junior Riding Classes - The mount of a Rider under 9 yrs must not exceed 14hh. The Mount of a Rider 9yrs & Under 12yrs must not exceed 14.2hh

- 38. Attention is drawn to Rule 16.2 (re Spurs) and Rule 16.2 (re whips) of the SHC Competition Rules
- 39. The policy will be enforced that during competition if first request to a Exhibitor/Competitor to comply with Rules &/or instructions of a Show Official is not followed A YELLOW warning Card will be issued, further non compliance shall incur disqualification.
- 40. Newcomer Exhibits not to have started under saddle prior to 1/8/2020 and not to have won an open champion prior to 1/8/2021.
- 41. Upon acceptance of Grand National qualification, all members travelling to Australia are expected to be part of the NZ team and its protocols, organised by NZSHC. Any breach of this may result in your qualification being invalid.

42. <u>Prize Money paid out as follows</u>: Grand National Qualifying classes – Champion \$80, Res.Champion \$50, Top Six Prize (excl Ch, Res.Ch) Gala Classes – Prize Pool Top Six Prize (excl Ch, Res.CH) All other classes – Champion \$40, Res.Champion \$20, Top Five Prize (excl CH, Res.CH)

Prize money may be substituted for prizes at the discretion of the show committee. If less than 3 entries in a class, prize money may only be paid to Champion at the discretion of the show committee.

43. <u>Additional Fees</u>: Catalogue Fee \$10 Stables \$25 per horse per night Open Yard \$20 per horse per night

COMPETITORS ARE TO AVOID ANY CONTACT WITH JUDGES VIA SOCIAL MEDIA OR ANY OTHER FORMS OF COMMUNICATION PRIOR TO OR DURING THE EVENT. IF THE COMMITTEE FINDS IT THAT SUCH BEHAVIOUR HAS OCCURRED THAT COMPETITOR WILL BE CONSIDERED INELIGIBLE TO COMPETE AT THE SHOW.

MEASURING

As the Show Horse Council measures in Hands and have our own height certificates.

Please remember to bring your existing SHC height certificate with you for remeasuring. New cards will only be issued for new measures.

Measuring of your exhibit must be completed on the Wednesday 9th February 2022 at Hastings between the hours of 12pm – 5pm, or on the morning of the show between the hours of 6.30am-7.30am (bookings required for Show Days).

GRAND NATIONAL QUALIFYING CLASSES

Three (3) judges will judge the individual classes without any conferring between the Judges. The presiding judge will be the first named judge for that class and in event of equality of scores the presiding judge's points will take precedence to break the tie. Only the top two of three scores will be counted. Complete final results of top six will be displayed in the secretary's office after the event.

Lead Rein, First Ridden and Rider classes will have set workouts. Please see workout section at end of schedule.

CHILD' S DAY CLASSES

Winners and Runner Ups will qualify for entry in the equivalent CHILD CLASSES at 2023 Grand Nationals in Sydney, Australia. Open to all children under 17 years. One judge per class.

First Ridden - Ponies not to exceed 12.2hh, Age of rider to be 5 years and under 12 years old on the <u>day of show</u>. Ponies to be ridden in a simple snaffle bridle with a cavesson noseband. Cane not to exceed 40cm, no spurs permitted. A narrow strap may be attached to the front of the saddle.

No cantering is allowed during the work on the circle – small amount of canter is allowed in individual workout (refer to workout). Ponies must enter and leave the ring at a walk or trot. This class will be judged on the suitability of the pony for the purpose intended.
