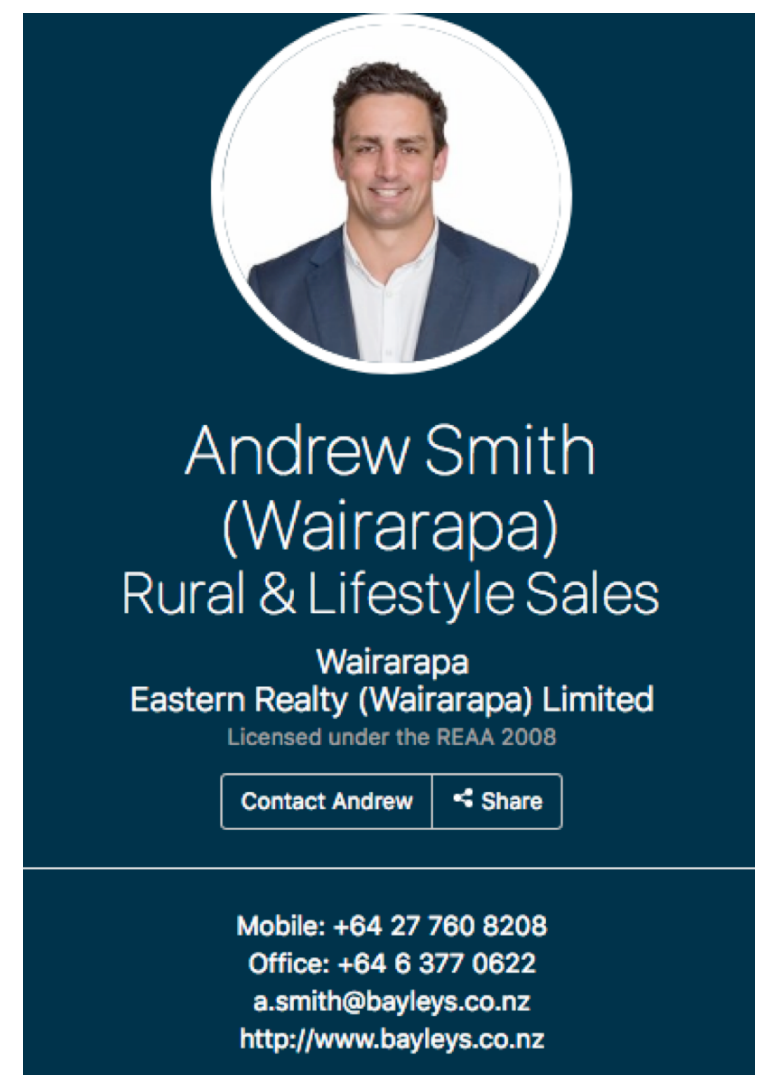

- Please remove any manure and hay around floats and trucks before you depart
- All horse and pony events will be conducted under the rules and conditions of the Wairarapa Horse Sports Federation. A copy of these will be available at the secretary's office
- Hard hats to be worn at all times when mounted
- Four entries or no event, six entries or no second prize
- Classes may be cut or combined at the discretion of officials depending on entries
- Local classes are open to riders residing within the Tinui and Whareama School districts (Blairlogie, Tinui, Castlepoint, Riversdale Beach, Homewood)
- Ponies may enter hack flat classes if rider is 17yr or older
- Prizemoney may be substituted with product of greater or equal value
- All protests, disputes and objections shall be decided by the protest committee. All protests in writing within 30 mins of the event to be accompanied by a \$50 protest fee
- Dogs to be on a lead at all times unless competing
- The committee reserves the right to alter the programme and or prizes
