RULES

1. NO PLAITING

2. ENTRY FEE: \$5.50 PER CLASS GROUND FEE: \$10 PER HORSE ADMIN FEE: \$5 PER COMPETITOR

- 3. Your entry fee must accompany your entry or it will be returned
- 4. Age of all horses is as of 1st August 2021
- 5. Colts over the age of 6 months must be handled by a person over the age of 16 years and must be shown in a bit.
- 6. Stallions may enter at committee's discretion
- 7. Stallions allowed to enter will be clearly identified with a RED S symbol on the bridle and handler/rider will also have a RED S bib or armband.
- 8. All riders must wear an approved safety helmet with a three point harness.
- 9. The show committee reserves the right to make alterations to the programme or cancel the show or combine or cancel any class as they see fit.

10. You do not need height certificates

- 11. The show will not be responsible for any accident, loss or damage that may be suffered by any exhibit, person or property and it shall be condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the committee indemnified against any claim in respect of any accident, loss or damage.
- 12. Competitors enter and ride at their own risk.
- 13. Any competitor found mistreating a pony or horse will be eliminated.
- 14. Any horse or pony deemed a danger to others by a committee member, judge or steward will be asked to leave the ring.
- 15. Rider on an open pony to be under 17 as of 1st August 2021, adults can ride ponies in the presented and novice classes or in the green section.
- 16. In all ridden classes, horses must be 3 years and over.
- 17. A novice is a horse that has **not won** more than five conformation classes at **ANY open (A&P) show.**
- 18. 50% of entry fees will be refunded with a vet or doctors certificate provided they are received by the show secretary within 7 days of the show being held.
- 19. Number holders can either be of breastplate form, armband or attached to the back of a rider. **Numbers will not be provided**
- 20. Back number list and catalogues will be posted on the Brecland Park Equestrian facebook page.
- 21. Entries close 1st April 2022
- 22. You are either a show pony or hunter pony you can't be both.
- 23. The judges decision is final no protests will be entered into.
- 24. Judging will commence at 8am sharp.
- 25. Catalogues will not be available on the day they will be posted on facebook.
