Rules Regulations

1. No horse entered for the Maiden Open Jumping Competition shall be ridden in Children's Jumping Competition.
2. Three entries or no events, five or no second prize, eight or no third prize.
3. All protests to be lodged in writing with the Secretary not later than 15 minutes after the event has taken place, protests to be accompanied by \$50 which will be forfeited if protest is not upheld.
4. The Committee reserves the right to make any alterations to the programme, to substitute trophies instead of cash, or refuse any entry.
5. All horses in Jumping Events must be entered in bona fide owner's name.
6. In all jumps except Maiden: one baulk or run off disqualifies.
7. It is highly recommended that protective headgear be worn on all events. It is compulsory for Jumping and all children's events.
8. Children may be allowed to compete in adult's events only if no similar event is included in the Children's Events.
9. The Committee disclaims all liability in the event of an accident to competitor or spectator.
10. Entry to Alfredton Domain is at your own risk.
11. Some of the classes may run concurrently. If so, it is up to the Competitor to decide which Event they participate in.
12. All horse and pony events will be conducted under the Rules and Conditions of the Wairarapa Horse Sports Federation.
