Classes 8 – 13 are combined with classes 1-6 in their respective heights. Those entered twice in one height, first round counts towards combined training score. Please try to stick to catalogue order.

*Show jumping warm up on Grass - **Please ensure that your horses hooves are clean before entering the showjumping arena***

Grounds open from 7am

NO DOGS ALLOWED

All manure, hay and rubbish must be removed

This event will be run under ESNZ Eventing Rules

Helmets must meet ESNZ regulations and must be red tagged

There will be no medic present. A first aider will be in attendance

Tidy Casual attire or competition attire for both phases

Bridle numbers or back numbers for dressage

Back Numbers must be worn for Show Jumping

Masks optional and please try to socially distance where possible. Due to the current spread of Omicron please do not attend if you are not feeling well. We will be running under the Covid Response - Red Traffic light guidelines.

No food or drinks available at venue, please bring your own. Please provide your own water for your horses.

There will be no medic present, all riders ride at their own risk

Concussion Rule – If you have suffered a concussion within the last 21 days then you are not eligible to ride at our event

The organizer reserves the right to make any alterations to the program or postpone/cancel the training day at their own discretion.

Dressage phase – esnz eventing tests. Whips are not allowed, spurs may be worn.

Vet or doctors certificate must be presented for a refund of your entries, less 20%.

All manure and hay must be tidied up – please take home or leave in muck heap provided (it is a bit of a walk from the truck park though).Strictly No Dogs Allowed

Do not jump any of the cross country jumps, any rider seen jumping these will be eliminated and asked to leave the grounds

Please ensure horses feet are clean before entering the fibre SJ arena

Helmets must meet ESNZ regulations and must be red tagged

Eliminated riders are not allowed to continue

No class changes will be accepted on the day

The organizers reserve the right to remove any horse or rider that they consider to be dangerous.
