RULES

- 1. PLAITING optional. Please wear appropriate attire, jackets optional.
- 2. All classes are \$5 to enter. This **excludes** the Ground Fee.
- 3. Your entry fee must accompany your entry or it will be returned

4. Age of all exhibits is as of 1st January 2022

- 5. Colts over the age of 6 months must be handled by a person over the age of 16 years and must be shown in a bit.
- 6. Stallions may enter at committee's discretion
- 7. Stallions allowed to enter will be clearly identified with a RED S symbol on the bridle and handler/rider will also have a RED S bib or armband.
- 8. All riders must wear appropriate footwear and clothing to display their horse safely.
- 9. The show committee reserves the right to make alterations to the programme or cancel the show or combine or cancel any class as they see fit.
- 10. You do not need height certificates
- 11. The show will not be responsible for any accident, loss or damage that may be suffered by any exhibit, person or property and it shall be condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the committee indemnified against any claim in respect of any accident, loss or damage.
- 12. Competitors enter and ride at their own risk.
- 13. Any competitor found mistreating a pony or horse will be eliminated.
- 14. Any horse or pony deemed a danger to others by a committee member, judge or steward will be asked to leave the ring.
- 15. Intro to Showing' Class is for Handlers who have never placed in an RAS Inhand Class.
- 16. A green horse or pony has not placed in an RAS Inhand Class.
- 17. 50% of entry fees will be refunded with a vet or doctors certificate provided they are received by the show secretary within 7 days of the show being held.
- 18. Number holders can either be of breastplate form, armband or attached to the back of a rider. These are optional but do make it easier for your steward and judge.
- 19. Entries close 15th May 2022
- 20. The Show will follow the COVID requirements applicable at the date of the show
- 21. The judges decision is final no protests will be entered into. This is a fun day & our judges are volunteer.
- 22. NZ Sport Horse or Pony definition can be found at -> NZ Sport Horse Register (mainevents.com)
- 23. Judging will commence at 12pm sharp.
