The Showing Day out is a fun day for everyone to come give Showing a go! Fun rings, fun judges with a fun atmosphere for everyone and **NO HEIGHT CERTIFICATES** required. Please be honest and enter sections per your expected height (as per RAS rules). Plaiting and show attire is optional, but a great excuse to dress on up and try out your attire for the upcoming season?

Our aim is to encourage more local riders to come out and experience the show ring. Our judges are all experienced 'Showies' and are there to encourage you into our sport. This day is open to all sizes, breeds and colours, just come have a fun day out, learn something new and leave feeling brave enough to enter other shows!

Each Section has an

- 'Intro to Showing' Class which is for <u>Riders</u> who have never placed in an RAS Show Ring only.
- The Green Horses Class is for <u>Horses</u> who have never placed in a ridden RAS Showing Class. This class will have no cantering.
- There may be combinations who can enter both the Intro to Showing and Green Horse class.

This Show is also being run as a Fundraiser for our 'Masterton A&P Showing Championship' help on the 18 & 19 February 2023. This event was well supported last year and included everyone from Hacks, Gypsy Cobs and Pony Club Riders with all competitors having the opportunity to win a dress rug.

We have big plans for our next show and if you would like to be involved in this event or have some ideas, please let us know.

Camping & yards/stabling available the night prior as required & can be booked when entering. All day competitors are required to use a yard, no tying to Floats or Trucks. Please leave these yards and surrounding area's clean & tidy.

The Sections

The showing sections can sound daunting so here is a fun breakdown of each:

Saddle Hunter (Horse or Pony) – the Saddle Hunter is a good looking brick layer or Dwayne 'The Rock' Johnson. Looks like a Greek god, built like a brick sh!t house but still handsome and knows how to boogie. They have a hard working attitude and look like they could carry you all day without breaking a sweat.



Riding Horse – the Riding Horse is a good looking businessman (or women) or a bit like George Clooney. Very well mannered, polite, dresses immaculately and knows how to get noticed on the dance floor. The Riding Horse might be a little more 'dad bod' than the Hack but they have a great head and is the one you wouldn't mind taking home to Mum & Dad.



Park Hack / Hack or Show Pony – These are the ballerinas of the horse world. They have model looks, legs to die for & lovely conformation. They like to be centre of attention, own the dance floor & can have more bling or make-up on than a drag queen.



First Year Ridden – open to all children under 10 years and is a walk / trot ring only.

Led Rein – open to all led children 7 years and under. This is a walk / trot ring only.

Pleasure Horse or Pony – they might not have the model legs or the statue of The Rock however it doesn't mean they also can't have a fun day out. The Pleasure mount is just that, a pleasure to ride and own.

YOU MUST CLEAN UP RUBBISH, HAY AND DUNG AROUND YOUR FLOAT AREA RULES

- 1. PLAITING optional
- 2. All Sections cost \$20 to enter.
- 3. Your entry fee must accompany your entry or it will be returned
- 4. Age of all horses is as of 1st August 2022
- 5. Colts over the age of 6 months must be handled by a person over the age of 16 years and must be shown in a bit.
- 6. Stallions may enter at committee's discretion. Stallions allowed to enter will be clearly identified with a RED S symbol on the bridle and handler/rider will also have a RED S bib or armband.
- 7. A pony is either a Show Pony, Hunter Pony or Pleasure mount. Similarly a horse can only be one of Saddle Hunter, Riding Horse, Hack, Park Hack OR Pleasure mount.
- 8. All riders must wear an approved red tagged safety helmet with a three point harness.
- 9. The show committee reserves the right to make alterations to the programme or cancel the show or combine or cancel any class as they see fit.
- 10. You do not need height certificates. Please enter based on the RAS Height Restrictions for your section.
- 11. The show will not be responsible for any accident, loss or damage that may be suffered by any exhibit, person or property and it shall be condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the committee indemnified against any claim in respect of any accident, loss or damage.
- 12. Competitors enter and ride at their own risk.
- 13. Any competitor found mistreating a pony or horse will be eliminated.
- 14. Any horse or pony deemed a danger to others by a committee member, judge or steward will be asked to leave the ring
- 15. Ponies can be ridden by adults in all open classes
- 16. In all ridden classes, horses must be 3 years and over.
- 17. A novice is a horse that has not won more than five conformation classes at ANY open (A&P) show.
- 18. A green horse or pony has not placed in a ridden RAS class. The age of the horse or pony is irrelevant (however must be 3 years & over per rule 16).
- 19. 50% of entry fees will be refunded with a vet or doctors certificate provided they are received by the show secretary within 7 days of the show being held.
- 20. Numbers will not be provided
- 21. Entries close 22nd August 2022. Late entries accepted with 50% surcharge to 24th August 2022.
- 22. The judges decision is final no protests will be entered into. This is a fun day & our judges are volunteers.
