ENTRY FEE: Members – \$7.00, Non-Members – \$12.00 – unless stated otherwise. The RAS. charge a levy of \$1.15 per entry, per class which has been incorporated into the entry fees and will be passed on to them.

PRIZE MONEY: First – \$15.00, Second – \$10.00, Third – \$8.00 – unless stated otherwise.

ADMINISTRATION FEE: An additional administration fee of \$5.00 per rider/handler is payable with entry fees.

JUDGING TIMES: Prior to Showday please check website/Facebook for any changes to class times.

For Presentation and Parade details and times please check catalogue.

The Horse section is run under the Royal Agricultural Society Equestrian, Competitors and Judges Rules. Please familiarise yourself with the General Regulations listed in the front of the schedule.

BOXES & YARDS: Covered stables are available and will be allocated at the discretion of the convenor. Costs are \$10 for stallion boxes, \$7 for covered boxes and \$5 for open yards per night. You MUST state on the entry form which nights/days are required. Fees to be paid with entry. Tape yards are not to be erected on grounds.

YELLOW CARD: This Show supports the RAS 'Yellow Card' system. A Yellow card will be issued for offences of abuse of animals or inappropriate behaviour as per the RAS Constitution and the RAS Rules & Regulations/Bylaws including the Equestrian Rulebook. Full wording of the 'Yellow Card' system is available to view on the RAS website – www.ras.org.nz

PROTESTS: See General Conditions at the front of the Catalogue.

PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR: All riders, including harness drivers, competing at RAS affiliated A&P Shows / Events must wear approved protective headgear. These must be tagged with a RED approval sticker prior to the day of competition. The current standards can be found at www.ras.org.nz — equestrian. Standard protective headgear tags are changing from 1st August 2023.

CLEAN SPORT: Competitors are advised that tests for forbidden substances may be carried out during the Show under RAS rules. A Forbidden Substance is: any substance capable of affecting the speed, stamina, courage or conduct of a horse, pony, donkey or mule by its action upon the central or peripheral nervous system or the cardio-vascular, respiratory, alimentary, digestive, muscoskeletal or urogenital systems.

RIGHTS OF COMMITTEE: The committee reserves the right to refuse or cancel any entry without giving any reason for doing so and reserves the right to make any alteration to the show timetable, or withdraw any event as may be deemed desirable. If there are insufficient entries in a class at close of entries, classes may be combined. Any unruly or dangerous animal or exhibit may be required to leave the showgrounds.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Online entries will not be downloaded or confirmed until payment

has been received.

- ARREARS No person who is in arrears with regard to entry fees, subscriptions, or any other show/event charge is eligible to compete at any affiliated show/event. Proof of payment will be required before any restriction is lifted.
- 3. All Stallions and colts (with the exception of Miniature Horses and Foals) must be shown in a bit. All stallions and colts must be identified by two (2) official 'S" identification badges, one attached to each side of their bridle, at all Shows/Events at all times. The rider/handler must also wear two RAS official (2) armbands (one on each arm) when in the ring. 'S' badges to be purchased from RAS Head Office or ESNZ; Stallions are eligible for any ridden classes at the show with exception of show jumping. Please refer to rules CDE14 in the RAS Equestrian Rules.
- 4. In all Hunter, Horse and Pony Classes the bona-fide owner shall include a partnership that exists at time of entry and has been notified to the Association or registered with the Royal Agricultural Society. A lease shall comply with the same conditions. The Association may require evidence of the date of sale of an exhibit.
- SUBSTITUTIONS. A veterinary certificate must be produced to the Horse Office staff prior to the event for any horse being substituted. The substitution MUST be owned by the exhibitor in accordance with General Regulation 2 above.
- 6. REFUNDS For any scratching on Veterinary or medical advice, a refund of 80% of the entry fee will be made. Advice of the scratching must be given prior to the judging of the class and the relevant Certificate to be given to the Secretary of the Association within 30 days.
- All class changes to be made to the Secretary by 12.00pm on Thursday 13th October 2022.
- 8. All Novice Horses and Ponies to be ridden in a snaffle bit (except Hunter Jumping Classes and Working Hunter).
- All saddlery and accessories to comply with RAS Equestrian Rules GR 5
- 10. A Novice is a Horse/Pony is yet to win six (6) first placings in conformation classes at any A&P Show at the time of the show. Wins accumulated in Hack Sections are transferable to the Saddle Hunter Section. Wins accumulated in Pony Groups A, B & C are transferred to Saddle Pony Hunter (Group D). District classes are restricted classes and wins do not count.
- A Novice Hunter is a Hunter that has not won six (6) first placings in a Hunter Jumping event over fences at any A&P Show at the time of the show.
- 12. Novices may enter the Open Classes.
- Novice Championships are not eligible for Open or Supreme Championships unless they have won their respective Open Class. Champion does not count as a win.
- 14. If a novice entry has gained six wins by the day of the show the competitor must advise the Horse Office and may change the entry to an Open Class. If an Open Class is not available for entry, a refund will be given.
- No Horse or Pony under 3 years old can be shown in saddle classes.
- 16. Riders of any age may ride ponies in Novice Classes. Rider's age is

- taken as at 1 August 2022.
- 17. Breastplate numbers and Sports Numbers only at this Show. Back numbers are required for the Hack and Pony Hunter Jumping events. The Back Number listing will be available on the Show website in the week before the show.

MEASURING: There will be no measuring on show day. Measuring days as advertised on RAS website. Enquiries to Paula McIlraith 027 222 4473 or Tracy McIlraith Ph 027 200 0863. Where height is a requirement of the section exhibitors must carry an official RAS Life or Annual Certificate and performance card. Failure to do so will result in elimination (CDE 1).

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE: All transport conveying Horse exhibits to the show will be required to enter the Showgrounds at the North gate entrance from the Main Road and must be parked as directed by parking officials. The judges are directed not to award prizes where hereditary unsoundness is shown to exist in classes for Brood and Stud Horses. Competitors are also advised that if they are entering more than one pony/horse that judging will not be delayed.

SPECIAL PRIZES (Not be awarded if exhibits are not of sufficient merit). All sponsorship identified in this schedule is done so in good faith, however, Ellesmere A&P Association will not be liable for the payment of any sponsorship not received from the sponsor.
