TUBERCULOSIS TESTING – All cattle entered for showing must be from a TB Clear Herd. A copy of a current TB test certificate must be attached to your entry forms. Exhibitors are also reminded of their obligations regarding the transport of cattle under the TB regulations.

For cattle from Declared Movement Controlled Areas – All cattle over the age of 3 months are to be tested, and have a clear test within 60 days prior to being moved to the show.

TB Animal Status Declaration Cards – All cattle entered for showing must be accompanied in transit by a signed and dated TB Animal Status Declaration Card showing an Accredited TB Free Status in accordance with present legislation. Animal individual numbers must be included on the TB test sheet.

For cattle being moved: A **NAIT** approved RFID tag will be mandatory for all movements of cattle including day old calves. **NAIT** approved RFID tags are white only. Please do not remove tags if cattle are identified with Animal Health Board or **MINDA** tags. As of 1st July 2012 a secondary tag is no longer required under the new **NAIT** scheme.
