

## Equifest Fees

1. Each rider receives 1 x wristband. Extra wristbands can be purchased via Main Events when you enter \$30 these are limited to 4 x extra wristbands.
2. A \$20 non-refundable admin and medic fee applies per rider.
3. A \$20 ground fee per pony applies.
4. Camping: Non-powered sites are \$30 per site up to 5 people camping on site
5. Yards (limited number): \$10 per pony per night  
(Paddock and camping available off-site on request)

## General conditions

- Each Rider MUST provide a helper for gear and do their own assistant referee duties or find someone else to do this.
