## SHOW CONDITIONS

- Run under ESNZ rules and Show Jumping New Zealand Rules, for Series conditions Refer to Annex 11 (SJ Rule Book).
- All entries must be made on the official online entry program of Main Events.
- Administration Fee is non refundable
- All entry fees and prize money are inclusive of GST.
- It is the rider and entrants' responsibility to ensure all rider memberships and equine registrations with ESNZ are current and must do so before the show begins.
- Prizes & Conditions for all South Island Series will be on the South Island Show Jumping Facebook Page.
- Competitors and spectators attending this competition do so at their own risk. Show Jumping Canterbury and the organisers disclaim all liability in the event of accident/injury/damage to riders, horses, spectators, or property.
- All injuries and accidents anywhere on the grounds must be reported to the office.
- Dress code: Formal required in R1 & R2, Minimum in R3 as per ESNZ Jumping Rules. SHH and SHP should always be in formal wear.
- The Committee reserves the right to alter, amend or delete any class.
- Prize money will be paid out as per the schedule and then on a ratio of 1:7.
- Please refer to the "Registration guide" on the ESNZ website for more information
- Hacks / Ponies may start in only ONE Championship class or Mini Prix or Grand Prix.
- DOGS ON LEASHES AT ALL TIMES
- The Show Jumping Canterbury Committee reserves the right to refuse or cancel any entry
- Coffee cart & food will be available on the grounds.
- By entering or attending you accept that you may appear within differing media streams that SJ Canterbury approves in attendance to cover the event. Your behaviour at the event and within the competition arena is at your discretion and is your responsibility. Please note that there might be live streaming at the event therefore the camera is on throughout the day
- It is the rider's responsibility to clean up all hay and manure from their yards/covered yards/stables as well as from around their float/truck, which is to be placed in designated areas NOT around trees. Any holes dug by horses MUST also be filled in.
- No electric fencing or taping is allowed, and please do not tie or fence your equines up to graze unattended.
- Riders must wear tagged helmets and must always be done up whether competing or training at any time on the grounds. Article 151 will be enforced. As per ESNZ Rules



- Concussions: Any rider that falls or has a knock to the head, must be checked by St Johns before remounting. Any rider deemed to be concussed will not be allowed to ride for the rest of the show. The new ESNZ fall card protocols must be followed. Should you fall during our event you will be issued with this card which must be signed by the attending medical officer (St Johns) before continuing and you must carry this card with you for the entirety of the show.
- Official Photographers assigned to the event by SJ Canterbury organising committee are the only media to be sold or advertised.
- JOB SELECTION: All Canterbury Area Riders MUST ENTER A HELPERS JOB Class in the Jobs Section when entering online. Once your job is confirmed, it is then up to the rider to find a replacement if they scratch after entry closing date. If a job is not selected your entries will be DECLINED. There will be a sign in and out procedure in the office for all jobs. \$80.00 fine for those who do not complete their job in full. Job Descriptions are available from the Event Secretary.
- BACK NUMBERS are intended on being used at this show. Any Customer owing fees as of Tuesday 29<sup>th</sup> November 2022 will be removed from the program and will not be able to enter the ring. Reinstatement will be only via the Secretary and strictly enforced.
- Any changes in Covid-19 Levels and Show Jumping Canterbury and NEC Christchurch's Covid-19 Health and Safety policies will be implemented and all riders must abide by these in full.
- Covid or natural disaster clause: If a show is cancelled due to either Covid 19 or any natural disaster or similar SJ Canterbury reserve the right to withhold 10% of all entry fees received to cover costs already incurred for the show.
- Any balances owing at the completion of the show must be paid within 5 days of the show. If any balances are outstanding Full Late Fees of 50% on your classes and administration fee will be added to your entire entry as penalty and remain due until paid in full.
- All equines while not being ridden, MUST have their name, name of person responsible and their telephone number clearly visible on their head collar and/or rug Article 200 7.1 as per ESNZ Rules.
- Gate Keepers Helpers Job – Please NOTE that this involves strict control of who enters the ring and now includes using the radio to communicate with the judges regarding every competitor. Therefore we respectfully request that only adults take on this job

### **Gentleman Rider Series - Tavern Harewood and Kay Buckley**

Trophy and a rug to the winner of this series over the three Canterbury Shows.

This is open to all Gentlemen Riders competing on a Horse only. Run over our 3 Canterbury Shows and points will be awarded to your best performing horse in Open Classes in both Jumping and Show Hunter.

Please indicate on your entries if you are eligible for this Series each show.

(Note equines can be unregistered to obtain points but will need to have a Casual Jumping Levy for the show as only open classes counted / riders must have a full ESNZ membership and be over 18 years of age at the show for points)

### **Ring 3 Hampton Oval Equitation Prizes - ConcretePower**

A Rosette will be awarded to both a horse and a pony combination each day of the competition over the three Canterbury Shows.

Only combinations that are only competing in Ring 3 will be judged for these prizes.

To be judged on potential to progress in the sport of show jumping, overall rider craft and turnout and of horse and rider.

Please indicate on your entries if you are only riding in ring 3 at each show and your name will show an asterisk next to it on the programme.

(Note equines can be unregistered and riders can be on a casual day membership or introductory ESNZ members as well as fully registered equines and riders depending on the classes you are competing in)

### **Master Class Jumping Rider Series**

Rug and Sash to the winner of this series over the three Canterbury Shows.

This is open to all Riders from the age of 35 and over. Run over our 3 Canterbury Shows.

Points will be awarded to your best performing horse in any 1.00m Open Jumping Class at Labour Weekend and Xmas Cracker shows. The final will be held in conjunction with the Horse

105cm Championship at Canterbury Champs with points awarded for the final class placements for Master Riders only.

Please indicate on your entries if you are aged 35 and over at each show.

(Note equines can be unregistered to obtain points but will need to have a Casual Jumping Levy for the show as only open classes counted / riders must have a full ESNZ membership and be 35 years of age at the show for points)

### **Cavalleria Toscana South Island Horse Grand Prix and Horse Mini Prix Series**

## **SHOW HUNTER CANTERBURY CONDITIONS**

- Show Hunter classes run under ESNZ Show Hunter Rules & SHNZ Equitation Series Conditions
- All horses/ponies may start in any class under the Casual Start system with the exception of ESNZ Series Classes where horses/ponies must hold an annual jumping start registration
- Ponies will not be restricted to their respective categories, but they **MUST** compete in the correct height category for HOYQ, High Points and ESNZ Series
- Prize Money and HOYQ points will be awarded to place getters being awarded 66% or greater in the Open Classes
- Rising Star Series Sponsored by **ConcretePower** and Young Horse Series – Sponsored by **Tavern Harewood**
  - A rising star is a horse/pony that has had three or fewer in any recognized SH class at the start of the current season
  - Run over three shows – Labour Weekend, Xmas Cracker and Canterbury Champs.
  - Three classes qualify per show – under saddle and two jumping classes
- Amateur Rider Series ~ Sponsored by **Coleraine Horses**
  - Run over three shows – Labour Weekend, Xmas Cracker and Canterbury Champs.

(Note equines can enter this if unregistered on a Casual Jumping Levy for the show/ riders must have a full ESNZ membership)

**CLASS CHANGES AND SCRATCHING CONDITIONS**

- Scratchings prior to close of entries or when riders have been issued with an ESNZ Blue Card – Full Refund, excluding admin fee
- Scratchings after close of entries will receive 75% refund of class fees with proof of inability to compete – excluding admin fee, ground and yarding as appropriate
- Scratchings without the above or if you are a late entry do not receive refunds of any kind
- All proof of inability to compete (vet or doctors certificate) are to be received by the event secretary in writing within 48 hours of the show
- Changing class 80% refund of original class and normal entry fee on new class
- Changes to classes must be made 30 minutes before the start of the class, except for the first class of the day which needs to be in by 5pm the day before
- Late entries must start first in all draw order competitions.
- Class changes are only able to be done via the following options; 1. Complete and sign a form in the office 2. Via Main Events on the message tab. No changes via social media, emailing or texting will be actioned.
- Late entries: Plus 50%. This includes all late payments. 50% of unpaid entries as at closing date will be added to your entry.

**STABLING**

- Stabling will be allocated on a first in and paid first served basis, apart from NEC leases and owners which take priority. Lessees and owners MUST enter by closing date to get use of their yards!

**\$5 ESNZ Jumping Levy (Compulsory)** – payable by all horses/ponies competing in Jumping and or Show Hunter.

**\$20 Equine Casual Jumping Levy or \$15 Flexi Start if Equine is ESNZ Registered but no ESNZ Jumping Start**

The rider must be a full member with ESNZ. Horse/Pony not registered for ESNZ J/SH can compete using this levy.

The Casual Jumping levy is \$20 for the show for non registered equines or \$15 for a Flexi-Start.

Can jump up to 1.00m on a pony and up to 1.10m on a horse. Cannot compete in series classes and will not be eligible for HOY points in SH.

**Introductory Rider Membership or \$15.88 Rider Casual Membership Day Start**

Riders may compete in Introductory class (80cm and under for ponies and 90cm and under for Horses) on an Introductory Membership or Casual Membership Day Start. All other riders must be full members with ESNZ – results will not be recorded with ESNZ for Introductory Classes.

#### HORSE PARTICIPATION AND IDENTIFICATION

- All horses must be FEI registered for the current year (note: all FEI registrations expire 31<sup>st</sup> December each year regardless of when in the year they are processed)
- Must have either a current FEI Passport or an orange FEI approved National Identification book (These are available from ESNZ and must be completed by a veterinarian and signed off by ESNZ prior to competition)
- All horses must have a current ESNZ Equine registration with an annual start for ESNZ Jumping
- All CSI 1\* horses must wear an ID number as per FEI rule Article 282, a three-digit ID number must be allocated to each horse by the OC
- All horses taking part in CSI 1\* competitions must be at least 6 years of age (FEI Jumping Rules Art 254 1.1)

#### HORSE INSPECTION AND MEDICATION CONTROL

- Horse inspection (trot up) will be conducted on a suitable surface. Handler's attire at the trot up should be neat and tidy. Horse's must be wearing their three-digit ID number at the trot up, assigned by the OC
  - Inspections are conducted by the FEI Veterinary delegate, President of the Ground Jury, Chief Steward, and jury members if available. Eith a FEI horse passport or FEI approved National Identification book MUST be available for inspection
  - Boot & Bandage control may be carried out at CSI 1\* events on all participating horses FEI Jumping rules Art 244
  - Should there be testing at a CSI 1\* - Either a FEI passport or an FEI approved National Identification book MUST be available for the testing official
  - Prize money for any horse tested will be withheld until results are returned
- ★ FEI Trot Up to commence at approximately 10am Saturday
  - ★ Best Conditioned and Presented prize will be judged during trot up

All riders and horses require FEI Registration. This can be applied for through ESNZ memberships and may take up to 3 weeks to process.
