PLEASE NOTE: Each Exhibitor must supervise their animals at all times and shall be liable for any hazards created, accidents, illness or damage caused by the actions of themselves or their animals at the Solway Showgrounds. Exhibitors must comply with the appropriate animal legislation and the Health and Safety in Employment Act 1993.

PROTESTS: Protests must be lodged in writing within 30 minutes of class being completed with a fee of \$50.00 which will be refunded only if protest is upheld.

ABUSE OF SHOW OFFICIALS WILL RESULT IN DISCIPLINARY ACTION, AS WILL PARKING IN NON-DESIGNATED AREAS.

NOTE: TUBERCULOSIS AND BRUCELLOSIS TESTING FOR ALL BREEDS: All cattle 3 months of age and over entered for a Show MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A SIGNED AND DATED TB DECLARATION CARD.

The animals must have:

Either a TB Free or an Accredited TB Free status, and in the case of breeding stock, be Accredited Brucellosis Free.

DECLARED TB MOVEMENT CONTROLLED AREAS: Cattle 3 months of age and over which are farmed or grazed within a Declared TB Movement Controlled Area must be negative to a TB test within 12 months prior to the start date of the Show.

All Other Areas: Cattle 12 months of age and over, farmed or grazed outside of the Declared Movement Control Areas must be negative to a TB test within 12 months prior to the start date of the Show.

Under the Biosecurity (Animal Identification Systems) Regulations 1999, cattle may be moved to a Show without official primary or secondary ear tags provided that:

- 1. The animals are moved directly to and from the place of the Show under the direct control of the owner.
- 2. The animals carry a mark registered to a breed society.
- 3. A permit to move the animals without official ear tags has been issued by AgriQuality New Zealand.

TB Trucking cards must accompany animals.

TB DECLARATION CARDS MUST BE WITH THE SHOW SECRETARY 48 HOURS PRIOR TO SHOW DAY.

HEALTH & SAFETY: Each exhibitor must supervise and control their animals at all times and shall be liable for any hazards created or accident, illness or damage caused by the action of themselves or their animals at the showgrounds. - 1. All alpacas must belong to a clear TB herd where whole herd testing is performed in accordance with the AANZ Voluntary TB Scheme. Copies of current TB Certificates to be enclosed with entry forms.
- 2. All alpacas entered in Championship Classes must be registered with the International Alpaca Registry (IAR) and carry a brass ear tag displaying its corresponding IAR number.
- 3. The exhibitor is the owner(s) listed on the alpaca's registration certificate. In the case of a registered lease, the lessee is deemed the owner.
- 4. The age of the alpaca is its age on the day of the show.
- 5. All exhibitors or handlers must place their alpacas in the pens allotted by the Convenor. Placement of alpacas in 'trade pens' will only be done with the permission of the Chief Steward.
- 6. No alpaca shall be removed from the show prior to the completion of the judging without the permission of the Chief Steward.
- 7. **For huacaya alpacas** this is a "short fleece" breed competition. All huacaya alpacas must have a **maximum** fleece length of 60mm and a minimum recommended fleece length of 30mm.
- 8. **For suri alpacas** this is a "full fleece" breed competition with alpacas carrying a recommended minimum of 50mm and with no maximum length. The alpacas must have been shorn within 36 months of the show.
- 9. **In the Fleece section**, Fleece may be up to 24 months of age from shearing, so long as it has no more than 15 months of growth for Huacaya and 36 months of growth for Suri and is from a registered alpaca.
