- e) Horse inspection for Classes 1 & 3 will be held at 7:30am on Saturday morning.
- f) Classes 2 & 4 will compete over the same courses as Classes 1 & 3
 - a. Class 1 & 2 Approx distance 3,850m Approx time 6:45
 - b. Class 3 & 4 Approx distance 3,280m Approx time 6:00
- g) Combinations entering Class 8 must both be ESNZ registered. Both horse and rider may compete under ESNZ Casual Memberships and must enter on the Official ESNZ Casual Membership Form available from ESNZ. Visit www.equestrian.org.nz (ESNZ membership details tab) for details.
- h) Cheques payable to "N.E.C." & include SAE for draw and supply e-mail address if not on entry form. Internet Banking payments will be accepted provided a bank account is detailed for refunds/prize money. Contact secretary for bank details.
- i) NO DOGS on Landcorp Block at any time. Dogs to be on lead during competitions.
- j) Refunds: Certificates Not Required. 100% if notified in writing (email) prior to close of entries. 80% of all fees if notified (email) prior to 5:00pm Friday 15th October. No refunds of any amounts \$20 or under.
- k) Cross Country will be closed for schooling from 5pm Saturday 9th October 2010.
- I) Official ESNZ Horse Trial Bibs and Medical arm bands to be used in all classes and phases.
- m) Truck/car registration must be supplied.
- n) All competitors and spectators attend at their own risk.
- o) All prize money will be paid out electronically by 1st November 2010 to the bank account on the entry cheque, unless a different bank account is nominated by attaching a bank deposit form.
- p) Class and division winners each receive one bag of Dunstan Feed from Dunstan's Eventing Feed range.

Stables/Stallion Boxes \$20 night/horse & Covered Yards \$15/night/horse. Covered accommodation allocated strictly first in first served.
