There are no horses to be left unattended tied to trucks or floats as per the NEC rules. All yards must be left clean.

There is limited covered horse accommodation available at the NEC. Covered yards will be allocated on the following basis -

- NEC Leased yard holders
- Sponsors
- Horses of rider's that are competing at 1.30m and above (includes all of these rider's horses)
- Horses of rider's who are competing in both week 1 and week 2 Easter Jumping Shows
- Horses of rider's that compete at 1.25m and above, attending all 3 days of the show (includes all of these rider's horses)
- Rider's competing on all three days of the show allocated on a first-in first-serve basis
- · Any remaining yards will be allocated on a first in first serve basis
- The organizing group reserves the right to allocate outside of these priorities as they see fit
- Premium covered yards and leased yards will not be available to horses not cmpeting in scheduled classes

Payment:	\$100 Nomination Fee is required per horse via Polipay at the close of entries. Full payment is required by March 25th. Direct credit is available to those who do not have Polipay, but <u>you must</u> email proof of payment to cathy@qualityprint.co.nz if paying via direct bank credit for entries to be accepted.
Late Entries:	Entries made after Thursday 16th March will incur a 50% late entry fee and are subject to availability.
Changes:	Class changes can be accepted via messages on Main-Events or email. No class change fee.
Scratchings:	Please apply to the Secretary for refunds. No refund for scratchings made after Thursday 30th March. Non-refundable admin fee \$20 per horse will be retained on acceptance of entry.
Refunds & PrizeMoney:	All refunds and prize money will be paid electronically following the completion of the show. These will be paid into the bank account nominated in your Main-Events account. Refunds of less than \$10 will not be paid out.
	Any queries must be made by the 24th April 2023 . No prize money or refunds will be paid out after that date.

General Conditions

- All competitors enter at their own risk.
- By completing an entry all competitors agree to abide by the Health and Safety at Work Act 2015 and both the show and the National Equestrian Centres health and safety policies.
- The organizing group reserves the right to alter or cancel any classes at any time.
- The organizing group reserves the right to change or amend the schedule, including prize money at any time.
- The organizing group reserves the right to refuse and or cancel an entry with no reason required.
- The organizing group decisions are final.
- Formal dress in all rings on Friday, Saturday and Sunday.
- The ring will run strictly in draw order and you must ride in your allocated slot.
- All fees and prize money are inclusive of GST.
- All riders, horses, and ponies must compete with the appropriate ESNZ registration.
- Parents are responsible for children under the age of 18 at all times.
- The ESNZ drug and alcohol policy will be enforced at this show. Underage drinking and the use of illegal drugs will not be tolerated.
