- 2- Entries close on **17th April** online at **Main-Events.com**, payment is required on this date.
- 3- Organisers reserve the right to make any necessary changes to the program.
- 4- Some classes may limit entry numbers, so enter early to avoid disappointment.
- 5- Those competitors already entered can make changes at the **Aon Insurance Brokers** sponsored tent.
- 6- \$10 per rider medic fee will apply to all competitors. **Medics on Scene** will be our Olympic medics.
- 7- \$10 ground fee will apply to each equine entered.
- 8- Be aware, start times are an estimate only.
- 9- Ponies and horses will compete together in most classes; adults riding ponies is allowed.
- 10- ESNZ membership or registration is not necessary
- 11- The same ponies can compete in a class with different riders in the **Cowboy Corral** and **Kelso Corner**
- 12- Casual riding wear, approved footwear, red-tagged hard hats to be worn by riders at all times.
- 13- A full refund of entries and medic fee will be given to scratchings before April 21, less the ground fee.
- 14- Refunds owing of \$10 or less will be taken as a donation.
