Conditions of Teams Entries

- Teams of 4 to be entered online by 6pm 12 April 2023.
- Teams can be made up of any 4 combinations across all classes
- Horses can only be entered in 1 team, riders can be in multiple teams on different horses
- The lowest total score of 3 combinations per team at completion of the event wins
- If you wish to be in a team but don't have a full team of 4, please send your names to us and we can help put together teams.

TIMETABLE

Saturday - Dressage and Cross Country

Sunday - Show jumping and Prize Giving (30 minutes after final results are posted).

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

1. This competition is run under ESNZ Eventing Annex 5 rules.
2. All riders to supply a jump judge. This is a condition of entry and entry will not be accepted without a jump judge. If you cannot provide a jump judge you can pay \$40 and a jump judge will be provided.
3. All competitors enter at their own risk and abide by the Health & Safety Act and the National Equestrian Centre's Health and Safety Policy. Health and Safety Plan will be emailed out and also displayed at the office.
4. Riders age as of 13 April 2023
5. Riders (Parent/Guardian) by submitting an entry means you will abide by the conditions of entry. BOP Area Pony Club accepts no responsibility for injury, loss or damage to property, horse or pony, rider or spectator.
6. STRICTLY NO VEHICLES/MOTORBIKES ALLOWED ON THE CROSS COUNTRY COURSE EXCEPT OFFICIALS
7. Any rider who has suffered a concussion within 21 days of competition may not compete.
8. 65 & 80 cm riders require a gear check for all three phases. 95cm – gear check before cross country only. 105 & 110 spot checks.
9. Medical armbands for XC/SJ are encouraged but not compulsory. (Please make sure your Emergency contact details are provided at time of entry).
10. The organising committee reserves the right to alter the schedule and split or combine classes.
11. The organising committee reserves the right to remove any horse/pony it considers dangerous.
12. Prize giving will be held for all classes approximately 30 minutes after the posting of the last class scores providing there are no protests. Protests must be submitted to the event secretary in writing within 30 minutes of the incident and accompanied by \$50 which will be returned if the protest is upheld. Place getter ribbons or rosettes each class 1st to 6th place – Dressage and Overall.
13. Refunds less Main Events fees and Admin fee if notified by 9am 10th April 2023. Thereafter no refunds for any reason. The Main Events fee is non-refundable.
14. The event will be held wet or fine. In the unlikely event of a cancellation, for example, due to extreme weather conditions or a natural disaster, this will be posted on the Bay of Plenty Area Pony Club facebook page the night prior and \$50 of the entry fee will be refunded.
15. An Ambulance and paramedic will be on site. All falls must be checked by the medic.
16. A vet and farrier will be on site for the event.
17. If eliminated on the XC you may NOT continue and must walk the horse back. After a fall, all horses must be led back.
18. Dogs must be on a lead and under control at all times.
19. Cross Country Course will be open for walking on Friday 14th April 2023 from 3pm
20. The Leg Up Campaign will help supply contact details of a "buddy" if you are new to eventing or need support.
21. There are no horses to be left unattended tied to trucks or floats as per the NEC rules.
22. All yards to be left in a clean and tidy condition. If your yard is left dirty you will be fined \$30.
23. Entries not paid at the time of closing will not be included in the draw and may be removed to waitlist if classes are full. In the event of entries closing early, payments must be made within 48 hours or will otherwise be removed to the waitlist if classes are full.
24. No changes of class after Monday 10th April 2023.
25. All phases will be run where possible in back number order.
26. Helmets must be worn on bicycles or E Bikes
27. Non-competition horses are not allowed on the grounds
28. Disciplinary action will be taken if any person purposely jabs a horse/pony in the mouth or for excessive use of the whip or spurs.
