#### CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

- ALL ENTRIES ON FIRST IN FIRST SERVED BASIS.
- Entries close with the Secretary, Main-Events, PO Box 448, Masterton 5840 on Wednesday 1st December. Tel 06 378 2310, e-mail xmasclassic@main-events.co.nz. EMAIL ADDRESS must be provided for communication with secretary. Class lists and entry details available after close of entries from www.main-event.com – event ID SHJ030. Riders must check their entries are online before 5th December to confirm receipt.
- Entry cheques payable to "National Equestrian Center" or "NEC" and are not banked before 1st December.
- All events run under ESNZ rules. Class 28 run under FEI Rules for World Cup Competitions.
- Entries to be on Official entry forms only. Riders, Horses and Ponies must have current registration for the duration of the show.
- Committee reserves the right to alter the programme and prize money, substitute prize money with goods to the same value, and refuse any entry without qualification.
- Prize money – all entry fees and prize money are GST inclusive. A GST receipt can be requested provided the rider's GST number is supplied with entry form.
  - All prize money will be paid out electronically, on a ratio of 1:7, by 5th January 2011, to the bank account on the entry cheque, unless a different bank account is nominated by attaching a bank deposit form.
  - Individual prizes payable to individuals in excess of \$500 will have withholding tax deducted from the amount in excess of \$500, at the rate of 20% provided a correctly completed IR330 is received by the Secretary prior to payment, otherwise at the relevant No Declaration Rate.
- Late entries – 50% extra
- Scratchings – Refunds less 20% if notified to the Secretary by 5:00pm Wednesday 15th December, otherwise less 50%. (NOTE: Refunds totaling \$20 or less will not be paid out). Class 28 – No Refunds unless veterinary or medical certificate produced.
- Objections to be lodged with Secretary, in writing with \$30 deposit, within 30 minutes of announcement of official results.
- Dogs must be RESTRAINED AT ALL TIMES – NO LOOSE DOGS AT ANY TIME AND NO DOGS IN MAIN ARENA PADDOCK AT ANY TIME. Owners that do not comply with this condition will be fined \$50 for each offence and persistent offenders will be asked to leave the NEC grounds.
- Hard Hats must be worn by all riders when mounted on horses.
- Food available on the grounds.
- Charges (for show) – all stabling and accommodation to be entered on Accommodation Booking Form provided on website www.main-events.com for show or by email from secretary. This MUST be included with your entries to secure booking.
  - Show Levy \$10 per horse, Open Yards \$5 per horse per night, Paddocks \$10 per horse per night (Minimum 3 horses to paddock), Covered Yards \$15 per horse per night and Stables \$20 per horse per night (Restricted to World Cup Horses and Stallions ONLY). Entries after the first 600 horses will only be accepted if horses are accommodated off-site. No non-competing horses allowed on the grounds.
  - Camping per Truck/Camper (including driver) \$15 per night for powered site & \$10 per night without power. IMPORTANT – you must provide your truck or float registration so that camping passes can be issued. It is a requirement of this show that camping passes are displayed on the dashboard.
  - Camping per person over 12 years old (in addition to driver) – \$5 per night per additional person.
- Motorbikes – To be operated in a responsible manner, hard hats to be worn, not operated by anyone under 15 and not to enter main arena paddock.
