REMINDER - Entries close this Wednesday 1st December!

That deadline is looming ... but judging by the entries to date, many riders have made a huge effort to get in early to secure accommodation. And entries look to be as big if not bigger for this year. Last year 753 horses competed! Entries must be POSTMARKED 1st December or emailed to be in on time. Late entries are 50% extra.

Don't forget to include your Stabling/Camping booking form with your entries. You can download the **full schedule and booking form** from http://www.main-events.com/event/883/annandale-christmas-classic/downloads and if you have already sent in your entries *without* the form, download it and send it now. We will hold your place in the entry cue provided you get it to us by 8th December.

Keep up to date on entries at www.main-events.com

We are just starting the processing of entries strictly in the order received. You will be given a customer code on the bottom of your record of entries which you can use to access your own rider page. The record of entries is emailed to you after we process entries. You enter the 3 letter 4 digit code in the MY CLASSES page under the show – this only appears if you are a registered user of www.main-events.com.

If you don't register, you can still view your entries class by class but it is not so convenient. The class lists on the website will be updated each night on the website starting with Monday, Nov 29^{th} – so start looking then for your entries.

Please check the emailed *Record of Entries* for any corrections – they can be made quickly and easily if you let us know. And yes ... correct spelling of your name or the horse's name is important. Also please check the **bank account number** of your cheque on the top right of the *Record of Entries*. This is the bank number we will use to direct credit any prize money or refunds. **It is your responsibility to make sure the account is correct!**

We should have the backlog of entries processed and up to date by Dec 1st – so if you *think* you have entered but it is not appearing on the website, then you need to come up with a pretty good excuse as to why we haven't received entries! It is your responsibility to check and make sure your entries have been received by 5th Dec. If you arrive on the day and we don't have entries, there will be no places to start.

No day registration or casual starts allowed

All classes at this show are above the height level for use of day registrations or casual starts. The ESNZ are now on a 3 day turnaround for memberships and registrations so there is **no** excuse not to have memberships and registrations up to date by the time the show starts.

Send your entries in now to make sure you meet the deadline, but you must send us stickers or rider pages as required as soon as they become available.

The Great Lake Challenge Open Horse class

We have had several Junior riders ask if they will be eligible given the Junior Rider class height to jump is 1.20 to 1.30 and the condition for the Great Lake Challenge is that it is restricted to horses competing in 1.25 or less. The answer is YES – you will still be eligible as the height of the class is the average between the low and the high making it 1.25. The only exceptions will be the Junior Rider and Pro Am classes.

Stabling/accommodation

Stabling this year will be handled by Rupert Vallance from Main-Events. By keeping a closer link between the entries as they come in or scratchings, we hope to have better control over the stabling and accommodation.

It is planned to label every yard specifically so that domino effect of one person taking one wrong stable puts every thing out of kilter doesn't happen! Rupert will be available on the Wednesday and Thursday around the stables to help get you sorted.

You are NOT to put your horse in any yard or stable if your name is not on it or there will be an immediate fine. If you have issues, Rupert will be there to sort it out.

Sponsorship
