## Thank you all and best wishes for the New Year

The verdict is in ... it was the biggest showjumping event in NZ with over 820 horses on the grounds on any one day of the show from 920 entered originally! As a committee, we are grateful to so many of you for being patient and working with us – it certainly was a challenge to accommodate the number of horses and the issues that arose.

It was only through the generosity of our main sponsor Annandale that we were able to secure transport to bring in an additional 100 portable yards so we were able to accommodate all horses on the grounds – a first for the show in many years. Thank you Annandale once again!

The feedback coming in from the riders is positive which is always encouraging.

## Prize Money and refunds to be direct credited

Prize money and refunds will be direct credited by 7 January with the exception of those who won more than \$500 in any one event. For those riders, we need an IR330 form or a GST invoice for all prize money.

To those riders who still owe money to the show, you will have been emailed or mailed an updated record of entries with instructions for payment. Please get this done asap as we need to finalise the show accounts by the end of January.

If you want a GST receipt from the show for your entries, please get in touch with your GST number. We will also require that you give the show a GST receipt/invoice for any prize money won – we can produce an invoice for you from our records if that is helpful.
