**GENERAL CONDITIONS FOR SHOW FOR ALL COMPETITORS**

1. Cheques to be made payable to NZ Breeders Show.
  2. Please include a copy of the pedigree with all horses entering age related classes with your entries.
  3. Late entries accepted at 25% extra and start at beginning of the class.
  4. Refunds less 25% – no refunds after entries close without vet or medical certificate.
  5. Please note – qualifications related to all age classes including showjumping, show hunters and led classes.
    - 5.1. The person responsible for the horse taking part in the series must be able to produce proof of age from the breeder or a veterinarian. In the case of discrepancy, the breeder's information will be definitive.
    - 5.2. The identification page of the NZIP identification papers must be completed and the breeding must be completed to 3 generations. Any exceptions to this rule will only be made in a formal application to the NF giving a full reason for the inability to find the breeding. No reasons need to be given for refusals to give permission for horses missing breeding from taking part in the series.
    - 5.3. For the led classes all handlers must be able to prove age of the horse and have 3 generations of pedigree documented. Registration Certificate from a recognized breed society, will be accepted and must be included with the entries.
  6. The organizing committee reserves the right to alter the program and prize money as they see fit (Article 144.4 ESNZ General Regulations).
  7. Any prize money won over \$500 in any one competition will attract withholding tax at 39% unless you provide a GST Invoice or an IR3 form.
  8. AS per the NEC Charges the following accommodation costs apply: (These charges must be paid with the entries.) Please state the nights accommodation is required for.
    - Open Yards – \$5per horse per day/night
    - Covered Yards – Yards \$15 per horse per day/night
    - Paddocks – \$45 per day, maximum of three horses per paddock.
    - Stallion Boxes \$20 per day/night per horse.
    - All yards and stables must be left clean before leaving or you will be charged for cleaning. Absolutely no taped yards allowed.
    - Camping fee of \$10 per truck (Includes driver) per day/night without power for show and \$15 per truck per day/night with power. Additional persons (over 12years) camping fee \$5 per night. A 'Facility Use Fee' of \$10 per horse.
  9. Dogs must be on leads while competition is in progress.
  10. The Organising Committee accepts no liability in the case of injury or damage to animals, riders, spectators or vehicles. (Article 160 ESNZ General Regulations). Enter the grounds at your own risk.
  11. Objections, complaints and appeals – refer to rulebook articles 167-171. Complaints must be lodged with the secretary within 1 hour and accompanied by a fee of \$50. The fee will be refunded if the complaint is upheld by the ground jury.
  12. Gates to and from the showgrounds may be locked after 10:00 pm each night.
  13. There will be a Barbecue Saturday Night at \$10 per head. Tickets can be purchased from the secretary's office on the day.
- SHOWJUMPING AND SHOWHUNTER CONDITIONS**
14. All showjumping and showhunter classes run under ESNZ rules. Horse and riders must be registered for competition with the ESNZ.
  15. Age Series classes, Amateur Rider and Junior Rider Classes run under SJNZ Series Conditions. Age Series classes also run under conditions in Annexe 9.
  16. Age Group (4,5,6 & 7) Show Jumping Championships – these competitions will be over three rounds one on each day of the event. These rounds will be judged under Table A (Article 238.1) over one round without a jump off. The winner will be the horse with the lowest number of penalties over the 3 rounds. If there are equal penalties for the first place, there will be a jump off. If

there are further equalities of penalties then the fastest time will decide the winner for the 5,6 and 7yo classes. The jump off for the 4yo class will be judged by a panel of three judges and judged on technique, movement, and ridability. All other conditions will be as for the series competitions. A qualification standard may be applied for horses starting on the final day down to a minimum of 12. The top 6 placed horses in each age group series before this event begins will automatically be granted a place in the final regardless of the number qualifying as long as they have competed in the two previous rounds at this show.

17. Starting order for the 5, 6, and 7 year old Show Jumping Championships, the first round will be in reverse order of the horses placing in the respective age group series. Those horses that have not had points in the series will be placed in a draw and will start before the horses that have obtained series points. In the second round, the horses take part in reverse order of their penalties from the first round. Those with equal placings will start in the order they were drawn for the first round. In the third round, the starting order will be in the reverse order of placings after the two previous rounds. Where there is equality of placings, these horses start in the order they were drawn in the first round.
18. To be eligible for the style prize, horses must not be wearing any hind boots other than fetlock boots intending for preventing brushing.

**SHOW HUNTER SPECIFIC CONDITIONS**

19. Show Hunter conditions – practice rounds held only on Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> January from 3pm -5.30pm. \$5 per round, pay at gate.
20. All classes carry Horse of the Year and National Qualifying points.
21. Classes may be judged back to back with the approval of the judge.
22. Horses entered in age group classes must compete in the correct classes relating to the age. Proof of age must be provided at time of entry.

23. You may enter a maximum of five Show Hunter classes per horse

**LED CLASS SPECIFIC CONDITIONS**

24. Due to insurance requirements, all handlers must be members of ESNZ and horses must be registered with ESNZ. Day members at \$5 per day and day registration at \$5 per horse are available. Please add to your entries.
25. Entry forms can be downloaded from the Main-Events website at [www.mainevents.com](http://www.mainevents.com).
26. Stabling – horses competing in the Show Jumping and Show Hunter sections will have priority for the covered yards. As there is limited Stallion boxes, colts not otherwise competing in the show may not be accepted for the led classes. You will be notified and given a full refund.
27. Please note all colts 3 years and over must wear a Stallion Badge on their bridel as per ESNZ regulations.
28. Horses may be tested for banned substances as per the ESNZ Veterinary Regulations.

**SIRES AND BREEDERS LEADERBOARD AT THIS SHOW**

29. The Sires and Breeders leaderboard will be based on points earned by all progeny of a stallion or breeder in competitions at this show (not including Junior, Amateur, Young Rider, Led Championships, and Led Family classes). Points will be awarded as follows – full conditions will be available at the show:

**SALES CATALOGUE**

30. Class 200 is not a competition but a class list of horses for sale. A printed catalogue will be produced for the show with each sale horse having a one page detailing their pedigree, profile, owner contact details, photograph and what classes they are competing in. It is up to buyers to make contact with the vendor. The new NZ Sport Horse Promotion Board is offering this as a service to the breeding industry and would ask that if you are not listed in the catalogue but subsequently sell a horse at this show that you also pay a \$30 fee to the show office.
