General Rules, for all sections including SJ.

ALL Dogs (even small dogs!!) must be on leads at all times.

Ridden horses must be 4yrs & over, Age of horses as of 1st August.

Any age rider in all rings.

Helmets do not need to be tagged but must be in good condition & have a harness.

Smooth soled, heeled boot must be worn when riding.

Stallions refer to RAS Stallion Rules

No classes will be held for people wishing to ring hop.

Ring specific rules are at the start of each section.

The judge decision is final.

Refunds will only be processed if received in writing with a vet or medical certificate within 5 days of the show.

Everyone is on the grounds at their own risk.

Please be ultra fussy to leave the grounds immaculate as their use has been kindly donated to us.

Ponies to be led by a leader/attendant 14 years and over with the lead rein attached to the cavesson noseband of a snaffle bridle. Leader/attendant must hold the rein with their left hand.

Riders unable to ride of the lead may only ride in this section

Ponies will be asked to walk and trot only.
