Accident, Injury & Other Loss	<ul> <li>Injury to competitors / spectators</li> <li>Injury to horse / pony</li> <li>Out of control horse / pony</li> <li>Pre-existing medical problems</li> <li>Allergic reaction to animals/plants/insects/environment</li> <li>Dehydration, hypothermia, hyperthermia, sunstroke</li> <li>Death by Accident</li> <li>Fire / Earthquake</li> </ul> PEOPLE EQUIPMENT ENVIRONMENT				
Dangers	<ul> <li>Injury by falling – breaks, strains, sprains, cuts</li> <li>Injury by unconsciousness</li> <li>Collision with people</li> <li>Collision with horses</li> <li>Lack of knowledge of pre-existing medical conditions – asthma,</li> <li>diabetes, allergies</li> <li>Dehydration, sunstroke, hypothermia</li> <li>Death by Accident – major fall, being kicked or trampled by horses/ponies</li> <li>Fire/Earthquake</li> <li>Person being attacked by a dog</li> <li>Horse or pony being attacked by a dog</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Lack of first aid equipment and personnel</li> <li>Lack of safety equipment, riding boots and helmets</li> <li>Riders MUST always be wearing helmets while mounted</li> <li>All helmets must be Yellow Tagged (as per NZPCA / ESNZ and RAS policies). The yellow tag is a visual confirmation that the helmet meets accepted Safety Standards in NZ.</li> <li>Riders will be checked at the gate. If they are wearing a helmet that is not tagged, they will be required to dismount and the helmet checked.
